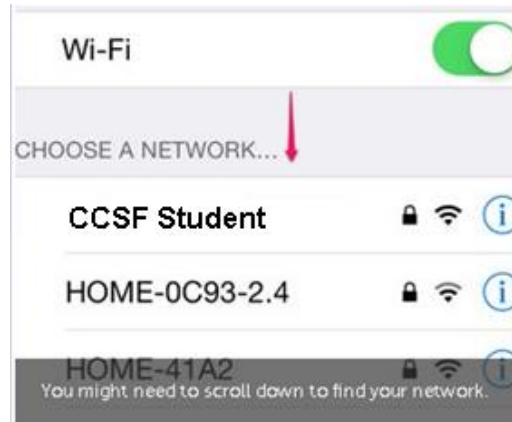


## How to connect iPhone, iPad or iPod touch to the CCSF Wireless Network

1. Open the iPhone **Settings** app and tap **Wi-Fi**. If the Wi-Fi slider is off, tap it to switch it on.



2. Tap the name of the Wi-Fi network you want to join, in this case tap **CCSF Student**.



3. Enter the WPA Key ( **freewireless4all** ) in the Password field and tap **Join**.



4. If you have successfully joined the **CCSF Student** Network, you should be able to see a check mark right next CCSF Wireless.



5. Open your web browser (e.g Safari, Firefox, etc.), and enter any URL (e.g. [www.ccsf.edu](http://www.ccsf.edu), [www.google.com](http://www.google.com), etc.). You should see the Welcome CCSF Student login page, where you will enter your **Username** ( e.g W00000000 or @00000000) and your RAM ID **Password**.
