We combine and schedule just the right courses to count toward three degrees and general education (GE) requirements all at the same time.



We accommodate students who have already completed coursework toward general education or a degree.

WADP students taking 10-12 units a semester, plus one course in the summer, can complete all three degrees in under three years. By taking one additional online course each semester, students can earn all three degrees in 21 months.
