

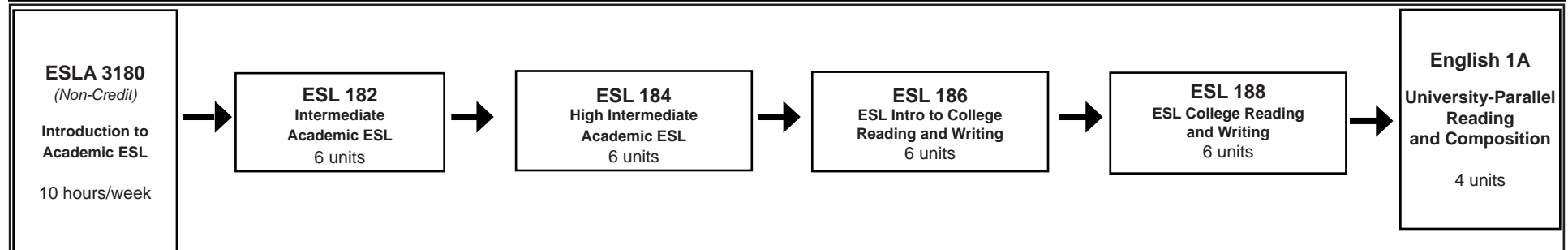

Test Placement for ESL (English as Second Language) - Spring 2019

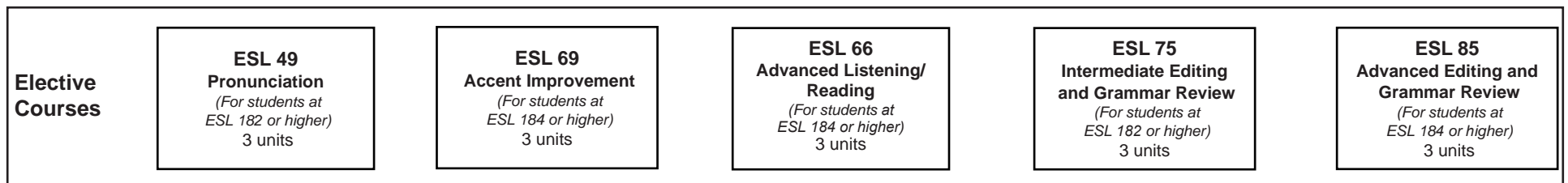
The CCSF ESL placement testing process is composed of two parts: a) the 90-item test of Reading, Grammar, and Listening skills and b) the ESL Writing Sample test. Students are placed into ESL and Math courses on the basis of their placement test results and additional student background information.
