# New Feature: Program Summary (pgs. 4-8)

There is now an easy-to-read Associate Degree, Award of Achievement, and Certificate Programs Index at the beginning of the catalog.

## New Associate Degree Graduation Requirements (pgs. 49 & 52)

Beginning with the 09-10 catalog rights year, the Written Composition and Math graduation requirements were increased to the level of:

- Written Composition (English): ENGL 1A
- Math: MATH 860 or equivalent (includes MATH 850 or 855, ET/CDEV 108B)

### ESL 140, 150, 160 (pg. 220)

These ESL courses, which were always CSU and UC transferable, have now been approved as <u>degree applicable</u> as well.

### Minimum Grade for Majors (pg. 52)

Each course in the <u>major</u> must now be completed with grade of "C" or higher (does not apply to GE).

## Addendum – Medical Office Assisting (pgs. 264-265)

The print catalog information for the Medical Office Assisting major and certificate is incorrect. Please refer to the attached Addendum and memo from Tom Boegel.

#### Multiple Majors/Degrees (pg. 54)

There is a new policy for Multiple Majors and Multiple Degrees.

#### Liberal Arts & Sciences Degree (pgs. 306-308)

The Areas of Emphasis are more clearly defined in terms of which courses are approved for Arts vs. Humanities, Science vs. Math, and Behavioral vs. Social Sciences.
