Course and Program Changes of Note

New or converted (from the Award of Achievement) majors for the CCSF Associate Degree:

Associate Degree Graduation Requirements (pg 46)

The Associate Degree for Transfer was added as an option. Catalog Rights language was modified to clarify that catalog rights end upon graduation.

Mathematics options

New options are available to satisfy the Mathematics graduation requirement for the CCSF Associate Degree (pg. 46) and for the Placement Test Waiver (pg. 16-17). A score of 3 or higher in the Advanced Placement Calculus AB or BC exam may now count as Math 100A (pg. 420).

Advanced Placement (AP) and English

A score of 3 on AP English Language and Literature and English Language and Composition exams now count as English 1A, and can be used for the Placement Test Waiver (pg. 16-17), Graduation Requirements, Area B (pg. 48) English Eligibility (pg. 224) and CCSF credit/equivalence (pg. 419).

Credit by Exam (pg 416)

Students no longer need to have completed 12 units at City College of San Francisco to be eligible for Credit by Exam. Students should *not* be enrolled in the course being petitioned.

Academic Renewal (see Catalog Addendum)

Language was updated to reflect that courses will not be lined out, but rather excluded from GPA calculations. Timelines and unit requirements were clarified.

Incomplete (pg 411)

Student and instructor responsibilities about Incomplete Grade removal deadlines were clarified.
