


Annual student headcount represents the number of individuals who take a class at CCSF, at some point during an academic year. Credit headcount includes students enrolled a credit class as of census. Noncredit headcount includes students with at least eight hours of attendance in a noncredit class. The overall headcount includes each student once whether enrolled in credit, noncredit, or both. On March 13, 2020, day 61 of the Spring 2020 term, City College moved to remote instruction to comply with the stay at home order enacted by the city of San Francisco.

How many students does CCSF serve each year?

Credit headcount decreased by 13% after seeing an uptick in the prior year. Noncredit headcount declined by 17%, from 2018-2019, after leveling off between 2016-17 and 2017-18.
