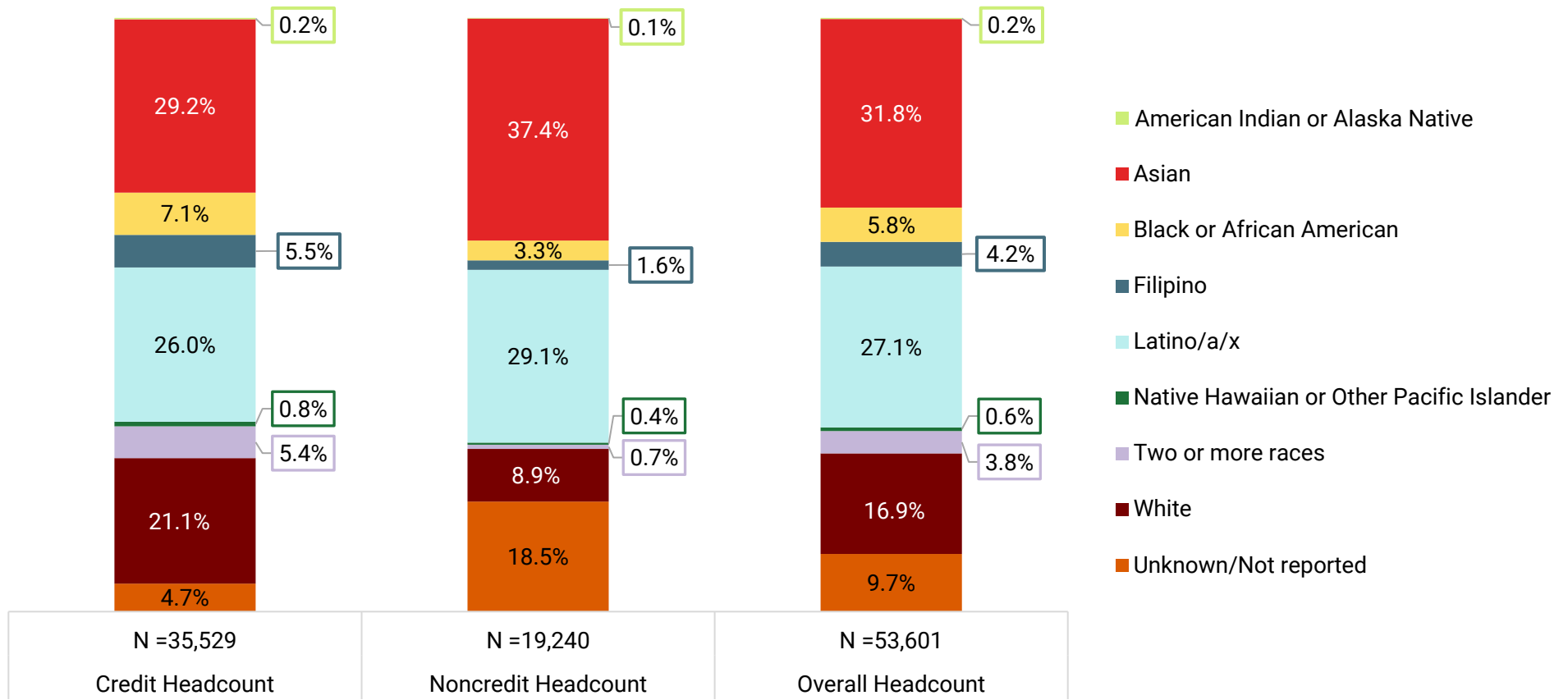


### Who are CCSF students by ethnicity, age, and gender?

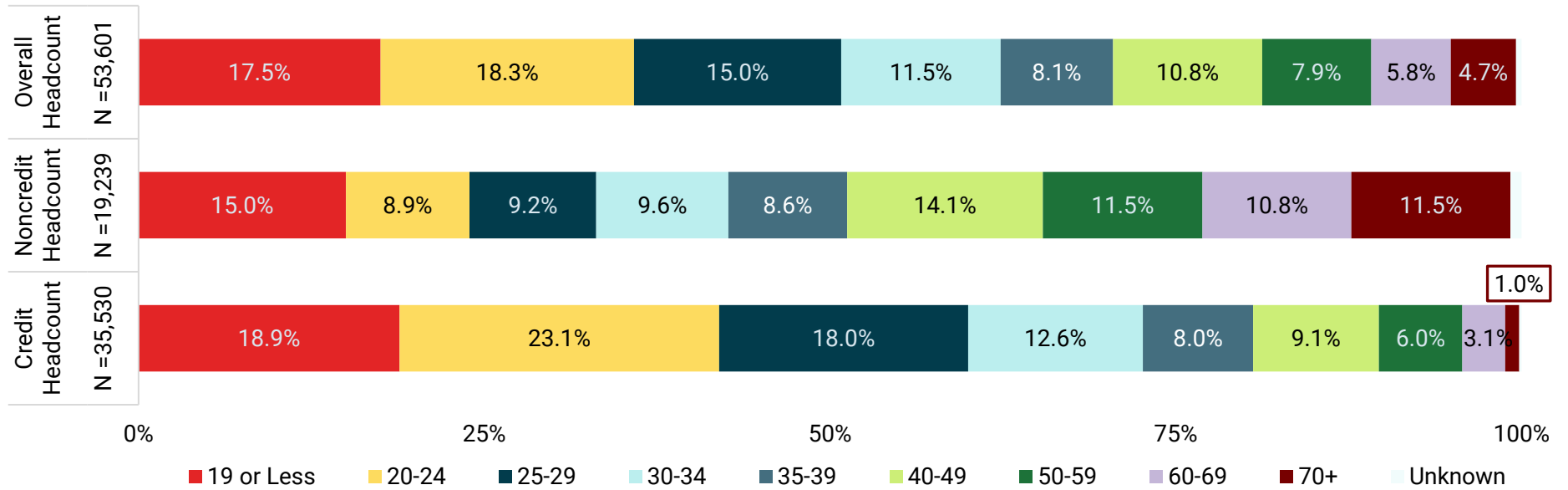
Among students enrolled in credit classes at CCSF, the most prevalent demographic groups are students who identify as Asian, Latino, or white, and students ages 20 to 29. For students enrolled in noncredit classes at CCSF, students who identify as Asian or Latino and students ages 40 and older are the most prevalent ethnicity and age groups. Students who identify as male are slightly underrepresented among students in credit classes, whereas students who identify as female outnumber male students nearly two-to-one in noncredit. On March 13, 2020, day 61 of the Spring 2020 term, City College moved to remote instruction to comply with the stay at home order enacted by the city of San Francisco.

Percentage of CCSF student headcount by student ethnicity group (2019-20)



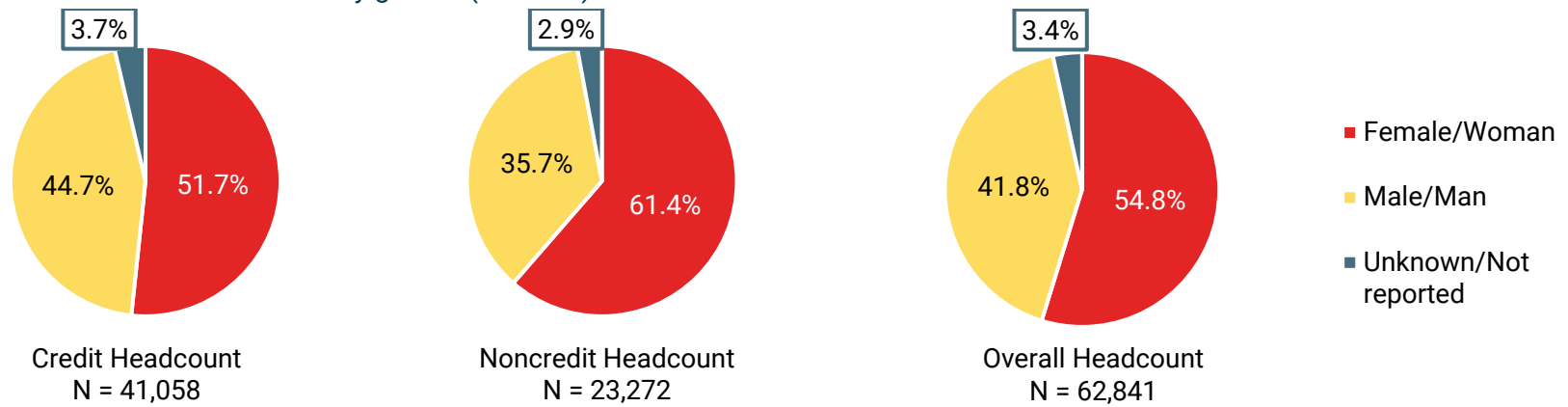
