

Bayview/Hunter's Point Education Master Plan: Overview, Framework, Process, and Timeline

Overview

The Bayview/Hunter's Point Education Master Plan is designed to document City College of San Francisco's commitment to the educational programs and student services for the residents of the Bayview/Hunter's Point neighborhood in San Francisco. It will focus on the College's commitment for programs and services for academic years 2021-22 through 2023-24 at the Evans Center (1400 Evans Ave.) and the Southeast Center (1800 Oakdale Ave.).

Process and Timeline

Development of the Bayview/Hunter's Point Ed Master Plan will be done following the College's planning processes. A working group, comprised of administrators, faculty, classified staff, and students will be formed to manage development of this plan. The planning process and the plan itself will be reviewed by the Planning and the Enrollment Management committees of the College's Participatory Governance Council (PGC). The finalized plan will be brought to the PGC for a final recommendation. During the development process, draft versions of the plan will be posted online.
