- Complete the New Student
 Online Veterans Orientation
- Submit the <u>Intake Form</u> to get your certification process started BEFORE registering for classes

- Email your DD-214, Certificate of eligibility (COE), & transcripts, No COE needed for Ch.31 (VR&E)
- Meet with a Veterans Academic Counselor to develop an Education Plan Request to see a Counselor **HERE**
- Register for classes based off only the classes on Education plan
- Submit the <u>Registration</u>

 <u>Conformation Form</u> after registering

RETURINO STUDENT

- If you have not enrolled in courses for two consecutive semesters or more, you are considered a Returning Student and must re-apply to CCSF.
- You will receive your same Student id & email within 24-48 hours.
- Update your Math & English
 Placement. only if you have completed a math and/or
 English class at another institution

- Submit the <u>Intake Form</u> to get your certification process started BEFORE registering for classes
- Meet with a Veterans Academic Counselor to develop an Education Plan Request to see a Counselor HERE
