Postcard Outreach

Objective:

To ensure that each San Francisco household receive information about how to enroll and register for classes at City College.

Method:

Bulk mail a 6 x 9, four color, double sided postcard to every SF household (389,519) with a message that includes the following:

--Did you know that City College is eager to welcome new and returning students this fall?

--Did you know that all non-credit classes at City College are free?

--Did you know that all credit classes are tuition free to San Francisco residents?

--Did you know that if you enroll half-time at City College and have completed a FAFSA (financial aid application), demonstrate an unmet need, are eligible to receive Federal Financial aid, and are meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP), you become eligible to receive a laptop computer/cash award and a grocery card?

--Did you know that while we are working on making it easier to enroll and register online at City College that this spring and summer we are offering safe in-person registration at several sites across the City?*
