ARTICULATION AGREEMENT CITY COLLEGE of SAN FRANCISCO San Francisco Community College District and San Francisco Unified School District Articulation Program Area: Biotechnology

City College of San Francisco (CCSF), in cooperation with San Francisco Unified School District, has agreed to grant placement in the biotechnology program to students who have completed the following:

- 1. The student enrolling in City College of San Francisco with the intention of gaining a Certificate or Associate of Science Degree in Biotechnology will participate in the matriculation process in English or English as a Second Language and Mathematics.
- 2. High school students may concurrently enroll in Biology 50, "Briefing in Genetic Engineering," during their junior or senior year with recommendation from their high school counselor or science instructor and permission from their parent or guardian.
- 3. Admission to the program requires the completion of one year each of a laboratory based biology, physics, and chemistry and one year of mathematics that includes algebra.
- 4. In addition, students who have completed one year of high school general biology and one year of high school Principles of Biotechnology may receive advanced placement in the program and may have the Biology 11 requirement waived. If Biology 11 is waived, these students are encouraged to enhance their program with courses in major's biology, genetics, or microbiology, particularly if they wish to transfer.

This Agreement will be reviewed by the High School Principals/Faculty and the College Program Chair annually and will remain in effect unless canceled by either party having given a 30-day written notice.
