Articulation Program Area: Computer Science





City College of San Francisco (CCSF), in cooperation with San Francisco Unified School District (SFUSD), has agreed to grant placement in the computer science program to students as follows:

1. Student enrolling in City College of San Francisco with the intention of gaining a certificate or Associate of Science degree in one of the Computer Science programs will participate in the matriculation process.
2. Students who have completed one year of high school AP Computer Science A with a grade of "C" or higher will have the CS 111A Intro to Programming: Java course requirement waived for the Computer Science degree and certificate programs at CCSF.
3. Students must provide high school transcript documenting completion of required course (as specified above) to the CCSF Computer Science department in order to have requirements waived.

This Agreement replaces all previous agreements for the program identified above. This Agreement will be reviewed by the High School District Administration, County Office Administration and the College Department Chair/Articulation Officer annually and will remain in effect unless cancelled by either party having given a 30-day written notice.
