San Francisco Unified School District**



City College of San Francisco, in cooperation with the San Francisco Unified School District, has agreed to grant articulated credit for students completing the following course:

High School Course: <i>Introduction to Architectural Design and the Building and Construction Trades</i> Credits: 5	CCSF Course Title and Number: <i>CNST 100 Intro to the Construction Trades</i> Units: 3
High School: <i>John O'Connell High School</i>	Department: <i>Automotive/Construction and Building Maintenance</i>

**Articulation Type**

Instructor: choose one of the following criteria for granting articulation

- Course to Course through **satisfactory completion of credit by exam and with a final high school course grade of C or better**  
 Course to Course through Waiver (course and grade will not appear on the student's transcript)

This agreement must be reviewed and re-signed every two years or sooner if curriculum was changed by either the high school or CCSF.

**This Agreement replaces all previous agreements for the program identified above. This Agreement will be reviewed by the SFUSD Supervisor of Career Technical Education (CTE) and the College Department Chair/Articulation Officer annually and will remain in effect unless canceled by either party having given a 30-day written notice.**

**Student Eligibility**

To apply for recognition of the articulated course, student will need to have:

- Completed the high school course named in this agreement
- Earned a grade acceptable for articulation
