City College of San Francisco, in cooperation with the San Francisco Unified School District, has agreed to grant articulated credit for students completing the following course:

## **Articulation Type**

Instructor: choose one of the following criteria for granting articulation

\_ Course to Course through **credit by exam with a final course grade of \_X\_ or better**\_X\_ Course to Course through Waiver (course and grade will not appear on the student's transcript)

This agreement must be reviewed and re-signed *every* two years or sooner if curriculum was changed by either the high school or CCSF.

This Agreement replaces all previous agreements for the program identified above. This Agreement will be reviewed by the SFUSD Supervisor of Career Technical Education (CTE) and the College Department Chair/Articulation Officer annually and will remain in effect unless canceled by either party having given a 30-day written notice.
