

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

City College of San Francisco

BUILD SAN FRANCISCO
San Francisco Unified School District

Articulation Program Area: Architecture

City College of San Francisco (CCSF), in cooperation with San Francisco Unified School District (SFUSD), has agreed to grant placement in the Architecture program to students as follows:

1. Students enrolling in City College of San Francisco with the intention of gaining a degree in Architecture will participate in the matriculation process.
2. Students who have completed the BUILD SAN FRANCISCO course, ARCHITECTURE AND DESIGN, and have received a grade of "C" or higher in both the course and its final exam, may receive one (1) unit of college credit equivalent to ARCH 48 Introduction to Architecture, Construction and Design Related Professions. Credit will be granted through the mechanism of credit-by-exam.
3. Students must request the credit-by-exam within 5 years of completing the BUILD SAN FRANCISCO course.

This Agreement replaces all previous agreements for the program identified above. This Agreement will be reviewed by the SFUSD Supervisor of Career Technical Education (CTE) and the College Department Chair/Articulation Officer annually and will remain in effect unless canceled by either party having given a 30-day written notice.


