Articulation Program Area: Hospitality

City College of San Francisco (CCSF), in cooperation with San Mateo County Office of Education (SMCOE), has agreed to grant placement in the Hotel & Hospitality Services program to students who have completed the following:

- 1. Students enrolling in City College of San Francisco with the intention of gaining a degree in one of the Culinary Arts and Hospitality Studies programs will participate in the matriculation process.
- 2. Students who have completed the SMCOE ROP Hotel & Hospitality Services program with a grade of "C" or higher will have the CARS 100 Introduction to Hospitality course requirement waived for the Culinary Arts and Hospitality Studies degree programs at CCSF.
- 3. Students may receive three (3) units of college credit equivalent to CARS 100 through credit-by-exam based on an exam given at the end of the of the ROP Hotel & Hospitality Services program.
- 4. Students must request the waiver or credit-by-exam within 5 years of completing the ROP program.

This Agreement replaces all previous agreements for the program identified above. This Agreement will be reviewed by the ROP Director/Faculty and the College Department Chair/Articulation Officer annually and will remain in effect unless canceled by either party having given a 30-day written notice.
