City College of San Francisco, in cooperation with the South San Francisco Unified School District, has agreed to grant articulated credit for students completing the following course:

High School Course: Automotive Technology Program Auto 2111& 2116	CCSF Course Title and Number: Intro to Automotive Mechanics - AUTO 50
Credits: 10	Credits/Units: 3
High School: El Camino High School; South San Francisco High School	Department: Automotive/Motorcycle, Construction, and Building Maintenance

Articulation Type

Instructor: choose one of the following criteria for granting articulation

- Courses (program) to Course through **credit by exam with a final course grade of _B_ or better**
- Course to Course through Waiver (course and grade will not appear on the student's transcript)

This agreement must be reviewed and re-signed every two years or sooner if curriculum was changed by either the high school or CCSF.

This Agreement replaces all previous agreements for the program identified above. This Agreement will be reviewed by the SSFUSD Supervisor of Career Technical Education (CTE) and the College Department Chair/Articulation Officer annually and will remain in effect unless canceled by either party having given a 30-day written notice.
