Stage 1 - Partial Return - Campus Limitations

CCSF Open to All Employees and a Limited Number of Students for Services & Instructional Support, but not Public and/or Non-Essential Public Events

General Institution Spring 2022

- 1. Management & classified employees are to resume and engage in their full work assignments:
 - a. For accommodations or work from home needs, please contact your supervisor and/or the Office of Human Resources
 - b. Continue to be flexible with campus shifts and working locations as needed to promote social distancing
 - c. Cross-training and/or alternate assignments to meet the existing needs of CCSF.
 - d. In-person meetings optional if safety measures are followed
- 2. Building access limited to personnel only and students with classes
 - a. Door monitors/campus ambassadors in place
 - b. Building filters to be updated with COVID standards throughout semester
 - c. CCSF outdoor facilities (i.e. track) are opened during business hours for individual use
 - d. Implementation of the R2C plans
- 3. Students are permitted on campus for the following:
 - a. Classroom instruction, office hours, counseling services
 - b. Study & shared spaces in designated areas (library & cafeteria area)
 - c. Technology needs, computer labs, food pantry
 - d. Student communications and campus signage will discourage unnecessary congregation on campus.
 - e. In-person registration
- 4. Face coverings and physical distancing will be required if person is in common/open area (i.e. restroom, breakroom)
 - a. CCSF to provide face coverings if needed
 - b. Max occupancy in common areas
 - c. Shared workspaces need face coverings
- 5. Administrative Services & Risk Management to lead with support from Academic Affairs & Student Affairs to implement the additional safety measures below:
 - a. Health shields, floor markings, hand sanitizer, etc.
 - b. Strict nightly cleaning protocols implemented in high traffic areas
 - c. Training made available on CCSF's <u>Infectious Disease Outbreak Plan (IDOP)</u> as well as **CCSF Online Training**.
 - d. Posters of campus and indoor safety protocols
- 6. All campus governance groups & search committees are meeting remotely, but options may exist for in-person meetings through a defined process if the entire committee so choses.
- 7. Continue and promote and market the COVID Safety Campaign and proof of submission
- 8. Ongoing outreach and monitoring to assist students with direct support services
- 9. Employee travel is optional based on employee's comfort level
- 10. Employee feedback submission opportunities (either email or digital comment box)
- 11. CCSF Website updated routinely with new information and campus-wide communications are consistent and timely

- 12. Positive cases through Student Health Services & general COVID inquires to HR

CCSF Open to Employees and all Students, outdoor public events, and limited indoor public events

General Institution Summer & Fall 2022

- 1. Management and classified employees to resume full work day on campus
 - a. For accommodations, please contact the Office of Human Resources (remote work is limited based on approved accommodations)
- 2. All buildings are open and operational with the following expectations:
 - a. Physical distancing not required but encouraged when possible
 - b. Building ventilation systems are up-to-date with COVID standards
 - c. Face masks required and provided by CCSF if needed
 - d. Door monitor concept revisited
- 3. Employees have been provided with training opportunities such as infectious disease training, and welcoming/belonging trainings as we return to campus.
- 4. Students may stay on campus throughout the day and may access most CCSF services inperson.
- 5. Room and space instructions are posted at each entranceway done through a inclusivity lens
- 6. Limited and safe food services will be provided.
- 7. Bookstore will be fully operational but will follow all health protocols.
- 8. Strict sanitation requirements for all spaces on rotational basis.
- 9. All campus governance groups & search committees are meeting in-person.
- 10. All essential and non-essential employee travel is permitted.
- 11. Any potential student exposure and/or health questions directed to Student Health Services.
- 12. Mass gatherings (i.e. flex day events) or events are required to follow specific CCSF/state guidelines.
