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Accreditation Steering Committee Objectives for 2021-22

- 1. Monitor the timeline and process for developing the Institutional Self Evaluation Report and ensure that there is broad participation
- 2. Receive draft responses to the Standards and other elements of the ISER and provide feedback
- 3. Finalize draft ISER for Fall 2022 Collegewide feedback
- 4. Prepare and submit annual and fiscal reports to ACCJC
- 5. Respond as necessary to requests from ACCJC related to being on enhanced monitoring

Progress Related to Objective 1 (Monitor ISER Timeline and Process/Ensure Broad Participation) and Objective 2 (Receive Draft ISER Responses and Provide Feedback). The Institutional Self Evaluation Report (ISER) Teams have been revising their drafts based on feedback from the Accreditation Steering Committee co-chairs and members/alternates. In addition, we have been collecting feedback from various committees and will share those responses with the ISER Teams for consideration at the end of May.

The drafting process has included identifying <u>potential improvement plans</u> associated with all subsections of the Standards; this list is a living document that we will be updating as we go. All are subject to change; we may still identify improvements within those that state "None to date."

We still plan to circulate the draft ISER collegewide and hold forums during Fall 2022.

Progress Related to Objective 3 (Finalize Draft ISER). We will produce a final, edited draft during Summer for release in Fall.

Progress Related to Objective 4 (Prepare and Submit Annual and Fiscal Reports). We submitted the <u>Annual Report</u> and <u>Fiscal Report</u> on April 8, 2022.

Progress Related to Objective 5 (Respond to Requests Related to Enhanced Monitoring). Actions to address ACCJC's concerns regarding our fiscal health are ongoing.
