The San Francisco Community College District recognizes its responsibility to conserve our State's energy resources. To this end, the planning, operation and maintenance of the physical facilities of the San Francisco Community College District shall have as an element the due regard for the conservation of our nation's and state's dwindling natural resources. Fossil fuels, electrical energy and water are the District's particular focuses. In this connection, the published conservation guidelines of the Federal government, the State of California, and the City and County of San Francisco are hereby adopted for the District. Implementing procedures and actions are contained in the Administrative Regulations.
