Dear CCSF Community,

This past December 2022, the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC), transferred ownership of the lower Balboa Reservoir lot (lower lot behind the MUB) to a developer group for the purpose of constructing housing. As a result, the lower Balboa Reservoir is no longer owned by the City nor managed by the college.

As we head into the Spring 2023 semester, CCSF will start to work collaboratively with the landowners and hopefully develop a long-term agreement at consistent parking rates. **Until this time, effective January 17th, parking in the lower lot will be managed by Douglas Parking. The initial daily rate for January parking will be \$6.50.** Douglas will post signage that will provide a QR code located at the ticket machines to facilitate electronic payment for parking – apps will not have to be downloaded. There will be no parking monitor on-site to accept payment.

The lot will be open for CCSF parking from Monday at 6 a.m. to Friday at 6 p.m. and will be closed from Friday at 6 p.m. until the following Monday at 6 a.m.

Douglas Parking will provide parking enforcement with fines assessed for parking without paid parking. **Student and Staff permits will not be honored in this lot but will be honored at all other campus parking locations.**

Please see the attached campus map for lower reservoir identification and open student parking areas. City College student parking in the upper MUB reservoir is \$5 per day.
