DISTRICT RESPONSE – ARTICLE 16 – WORK ENVIRONMENT

April 13, 2023

16.A District shall maintain levels of cleanliness, lighting, ventilation, temperature, security, and safety necessary and conducive to optimum learning, teaching, and other campus activities.

The District will consider alternative work spaces on campus for faculty when currently-assigned spaces are unable to meet the provisions of 16.A; including temporarily moving classrooms/offices to other locations at the same campus.

16.D The District shall make every effort to provide-<u>(within time, space and budget limitations)</u> secure spaces to store teaching materials and meet with students.

16.E The District shall make every effort to provide-<u>(within time, space and budget limitations)</u> a sufficient number of gender-<u>inclusive</u> -<u>appropriate</u> restrooms, breast-pumping lactation rooms, and other spaces for necessary daily functions.
