students who transferred from CCSF in AY 2016-17 and 2017-18

OVERVIEW

This document summarizes a selection of academic characteristics for students who transferred from CCSF in to a 4-year college or university, in academic years 2016-17 and 2017-18. The data tables include counts of students who transferred disaggregated by transfer destination category, IGETC certificate completion, type of degree(s) earned at CCSF, along with units accumulated at CCSF and completion of CCSF General Education (GE) Areas G and H courses.

METHODOLOGY AND SOURCE

- AY 2016-17 includes fall 2016, spring 2017, and summer 2017 terms. AY 2017-18 includes fall 2017, spring 2018, and summer 2018 terms.
- CCSF units earned: sum of units for all courses successfully completed by a student at CCSF.
- Completed a course: successful completion of a course that fulfilled an Area G or H GE requirement.
- The standard definition of course success (student earned an A, B, C, or P grade) is used for course completions to calculate hours earned and fulfillment of GE Areas G and H. While a D grade can be counted as transfer units, including courses where a student earned a D grade results for this analysis results in only an additional 15 students (0.5% of transfers) fulfilling a combination of GE Areas G and H.
- Transfer cohort methodology: students who transferred to 4-year institutions, after earning at least 12 units at CCSF, whose first credit term at CCSF was within 10 years of the transfer date, and who had no recent prior 4-year institution enrollments and no record of graduation from a 4-year institution prior to their first credit term at CCSF.
