



CTE DATA TRENDS: ANNUAL HEADCOUNT

Annual student headcount represents the number of individuals who take a class at CCSF, at some point during an academic year. CTE headcount includes students who achieved a CTE milestone, defined as completing at least 9 credit units or at least 48 positive attendance hours in a CTE course, within an academic year. CTE courses are defined as any course with a vocational TOP code, credit courses with a vocational SAM code, or noncredit courses with a vocational CB22 code. Students who met both the credit and noncredit milestones are counted only once in the overall student headcount.

Both CTE and non-CTE student headcount saw similar trends – declining from 2011-12 to 2016-17 and then rising slightly since. However, CTE headcount has increased each of the last two years while non-CTE student headcount has leveled off.

Figure 1. Annual CTE, non-CTE, and overall student headcount from 2011-12 to 2018-19

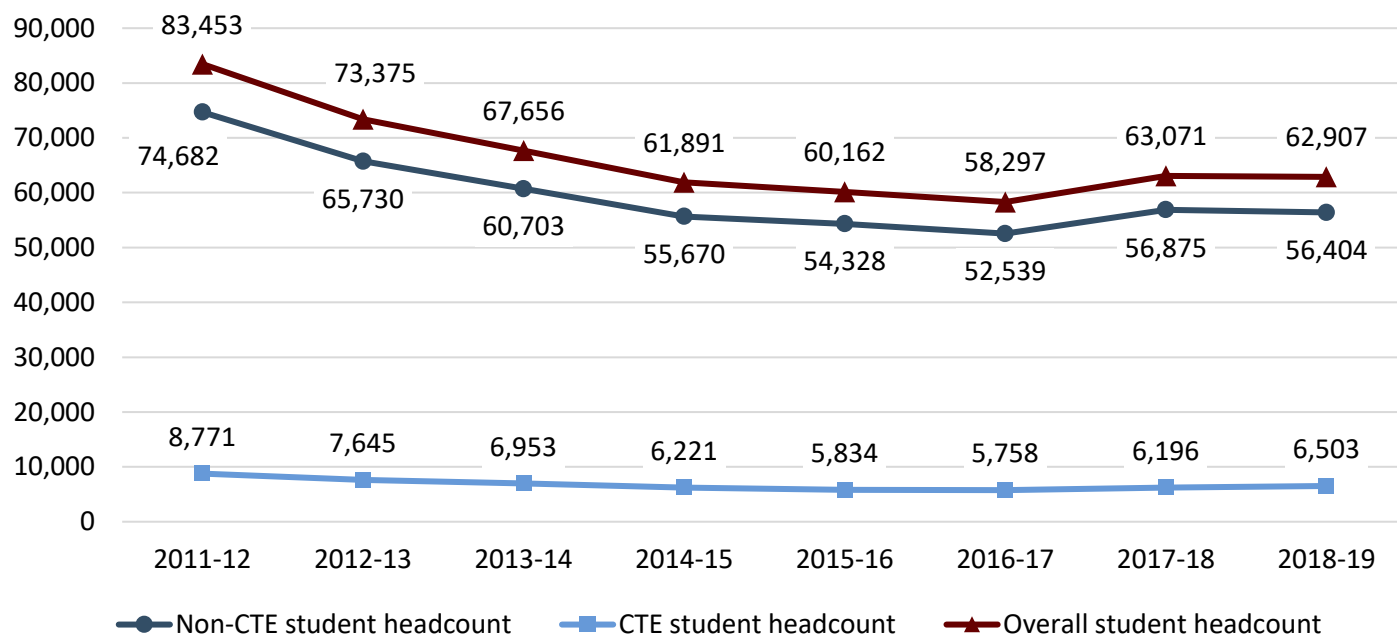
