

## CTE DATA TRENDS: CREDIT COURSE SUCCESS

Successful completion of a course is determined by a grade of C or better. The course success rate is the number of successful completions as a proportion of all enrollments.

For both CTE and non-CTE courses, the percentage of all credit enrollments that resulted in a successful course completion increased by approximately three percentage points

between 2011-12 and 2018-19. Success rates in CTE courses range from three to seven percentage points higher than non-CTE courses.
