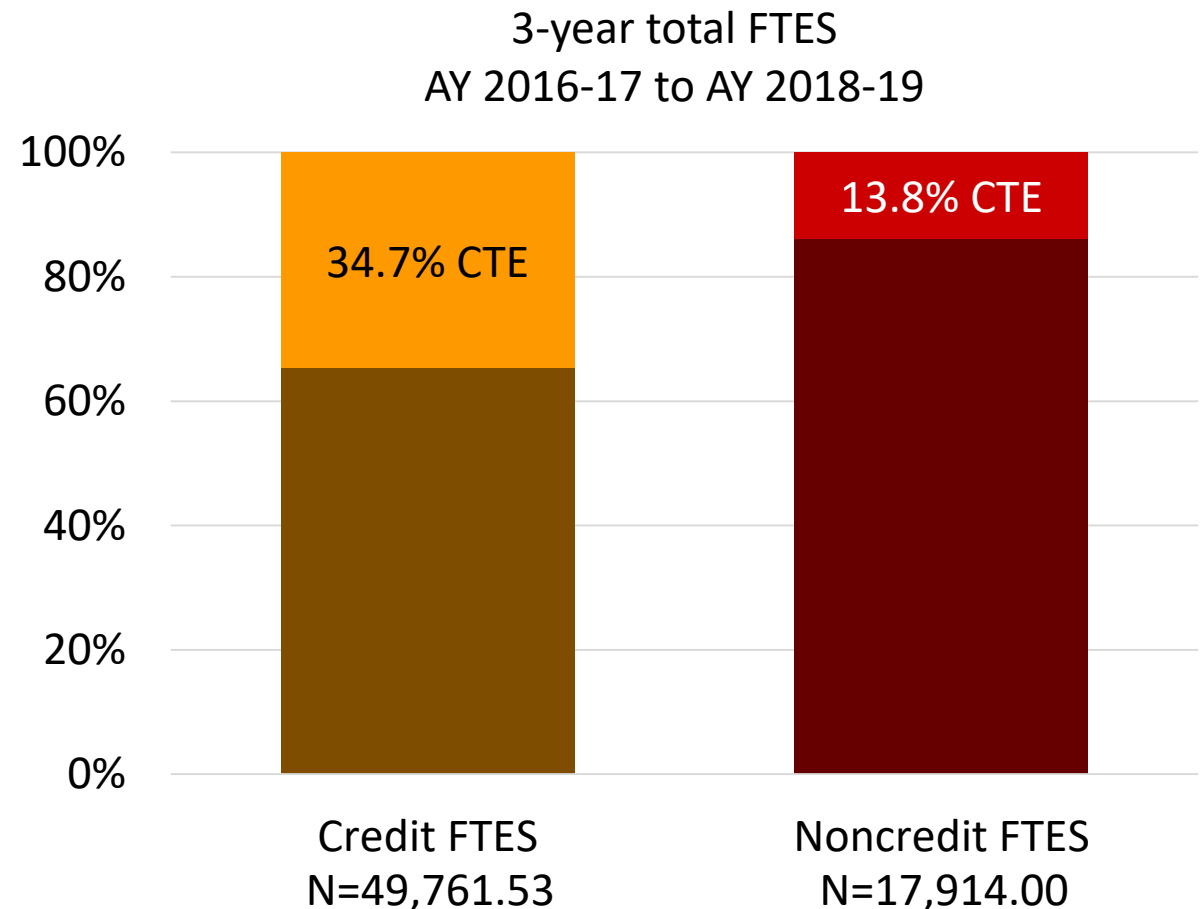

How much of CCSF is CTE?

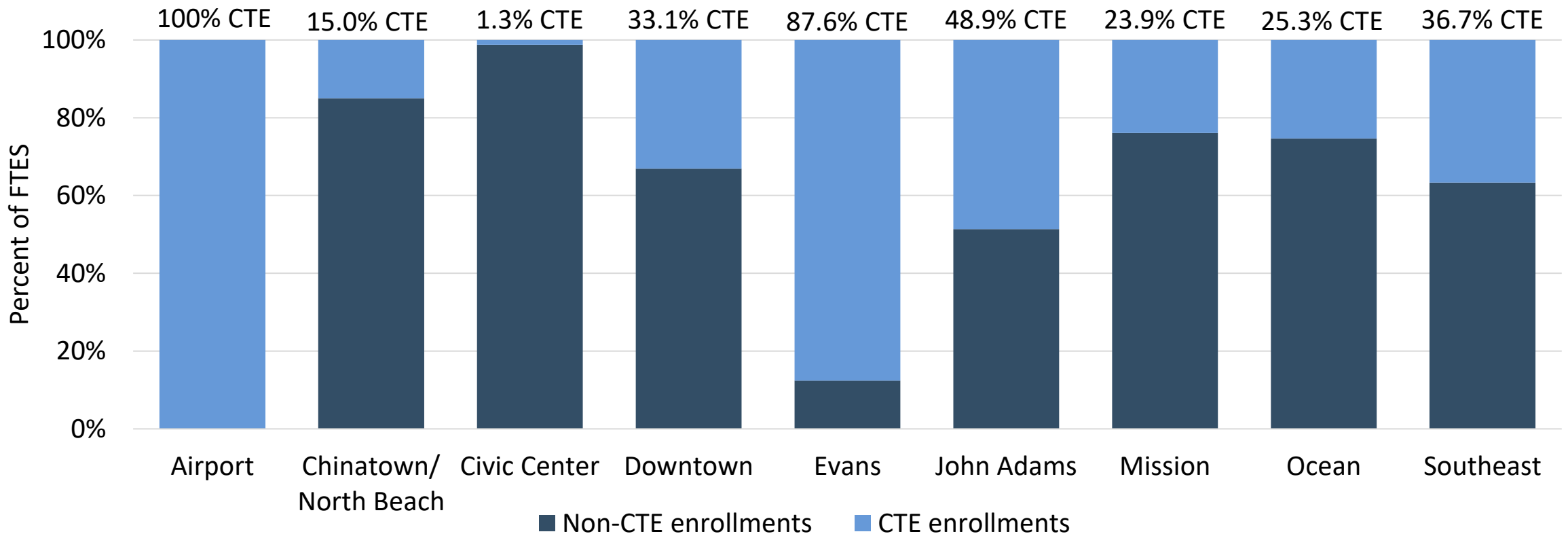
How many credit and noncredit FTES are in CTE and non-CTE?

Between AY 2016-17 and AY 2018-19, 29% of the college's total FTES were in CTE.



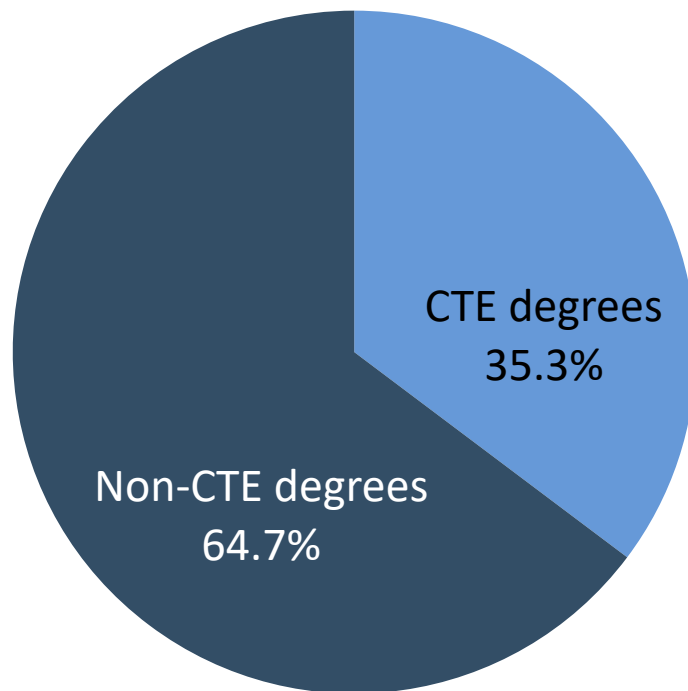
Which locations have CTE FTES?

3-year total FTES, AY 2016-17 to AY 2018-19, N=61,854.92

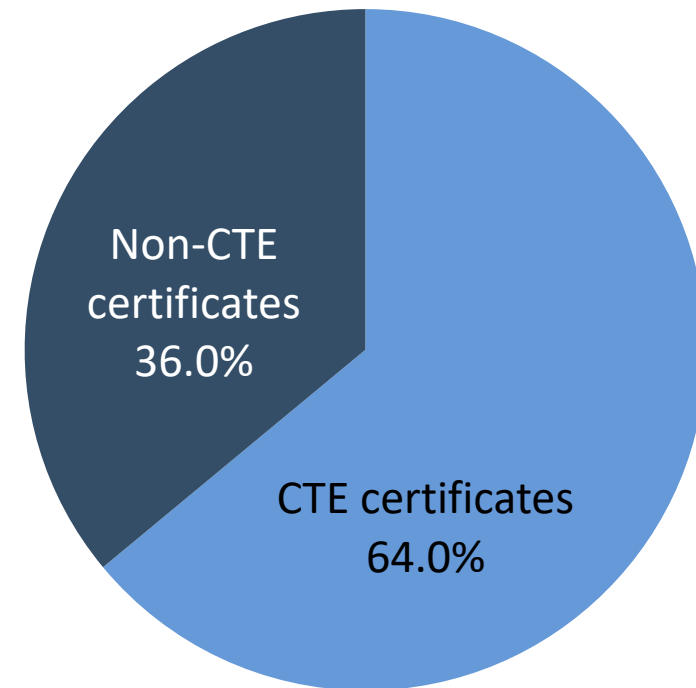


How many degrees and certificates are awarded in CTE and non-CTE?

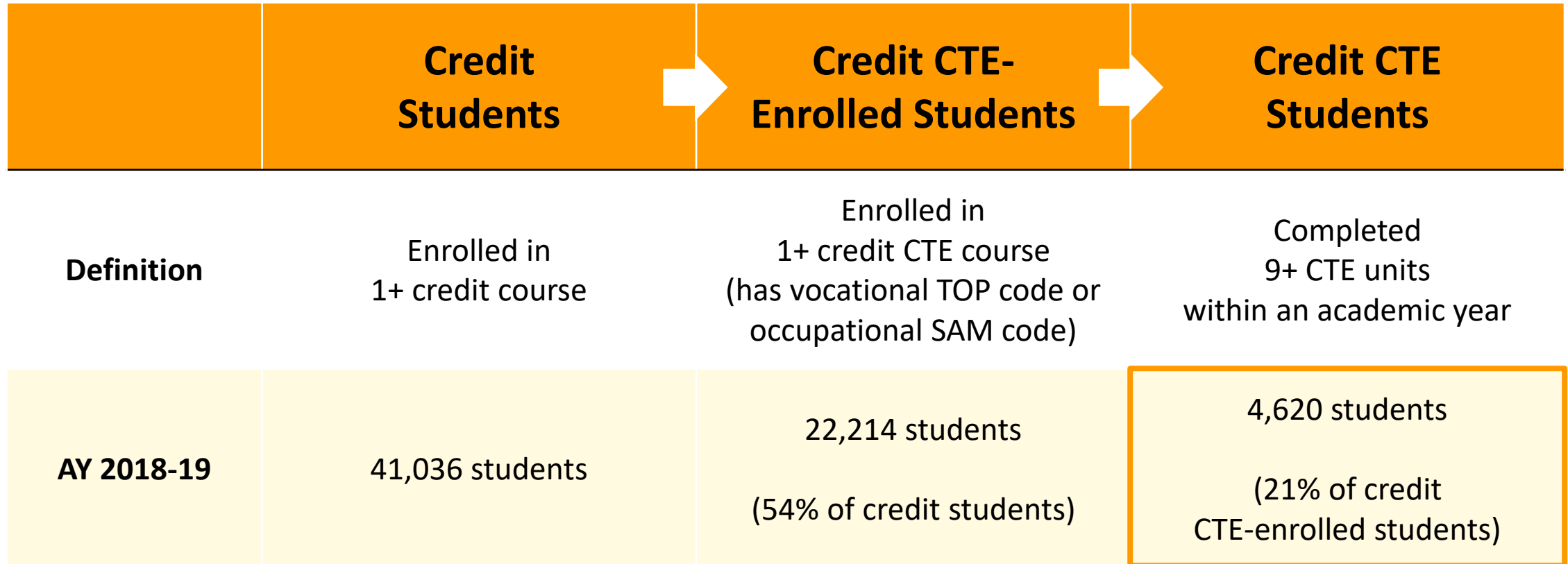


3-year total certificates

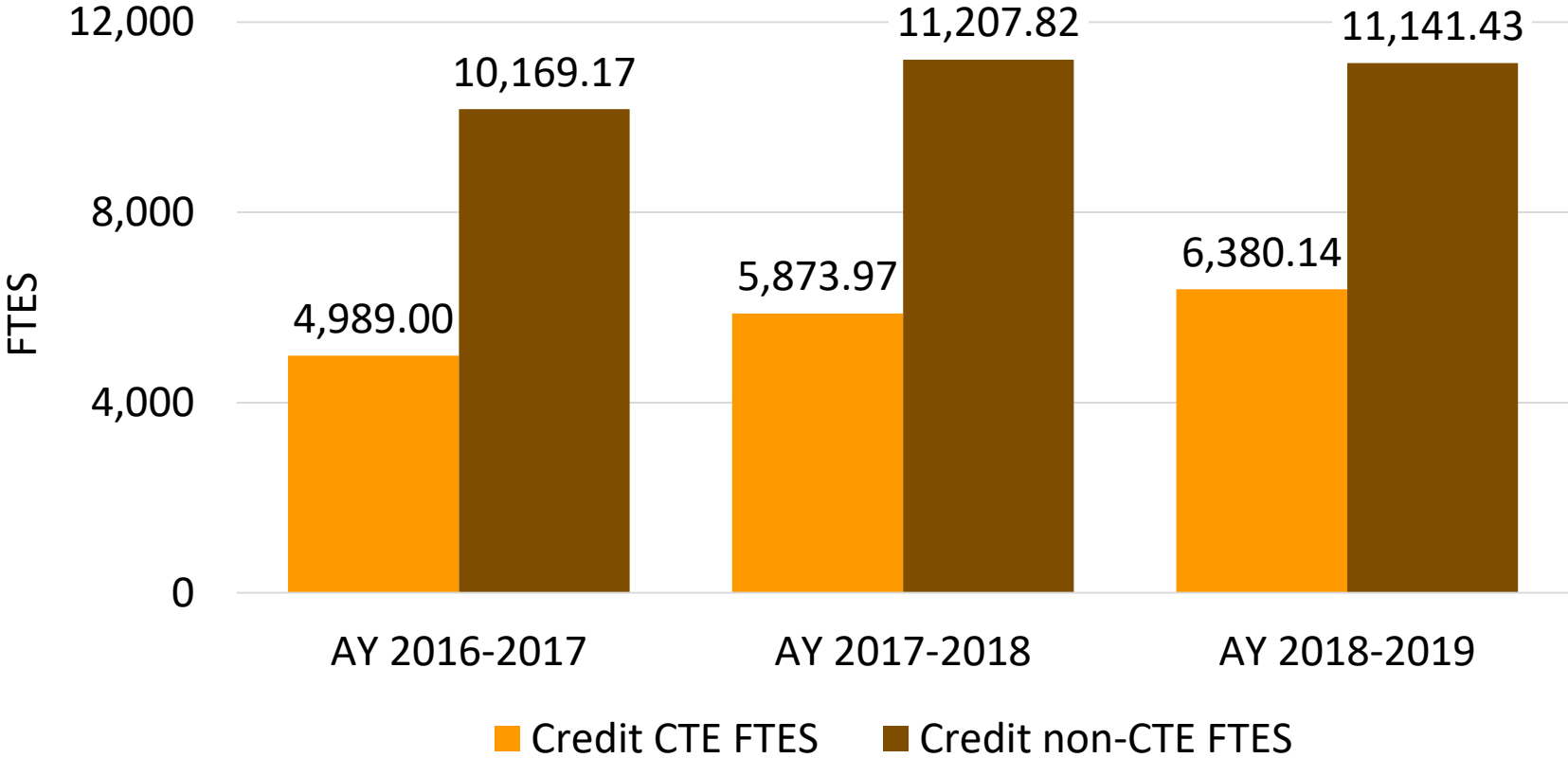

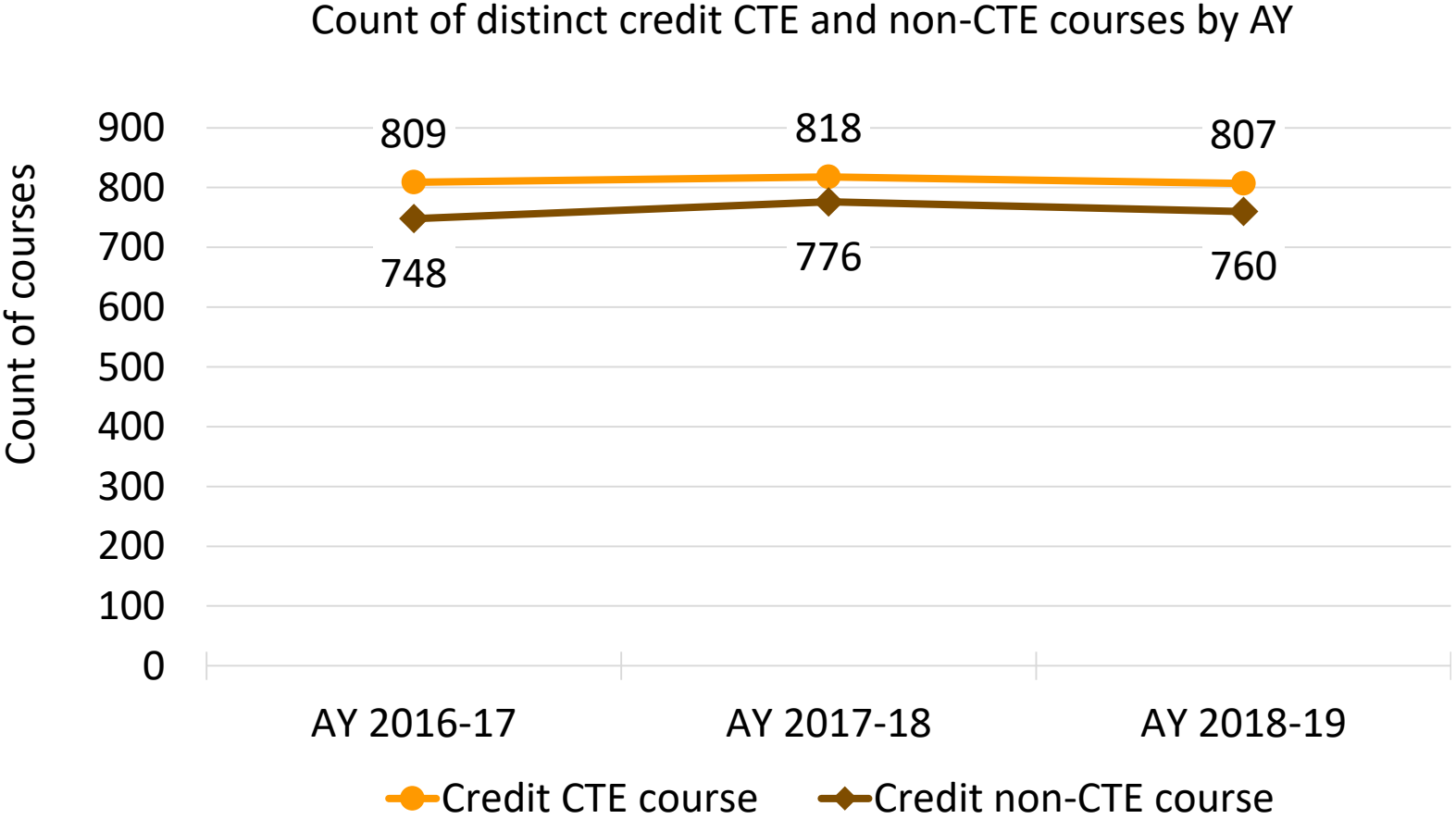
Credit CTE and non-CTE: FTES

Credit CTE and non-CTE FTES by AY



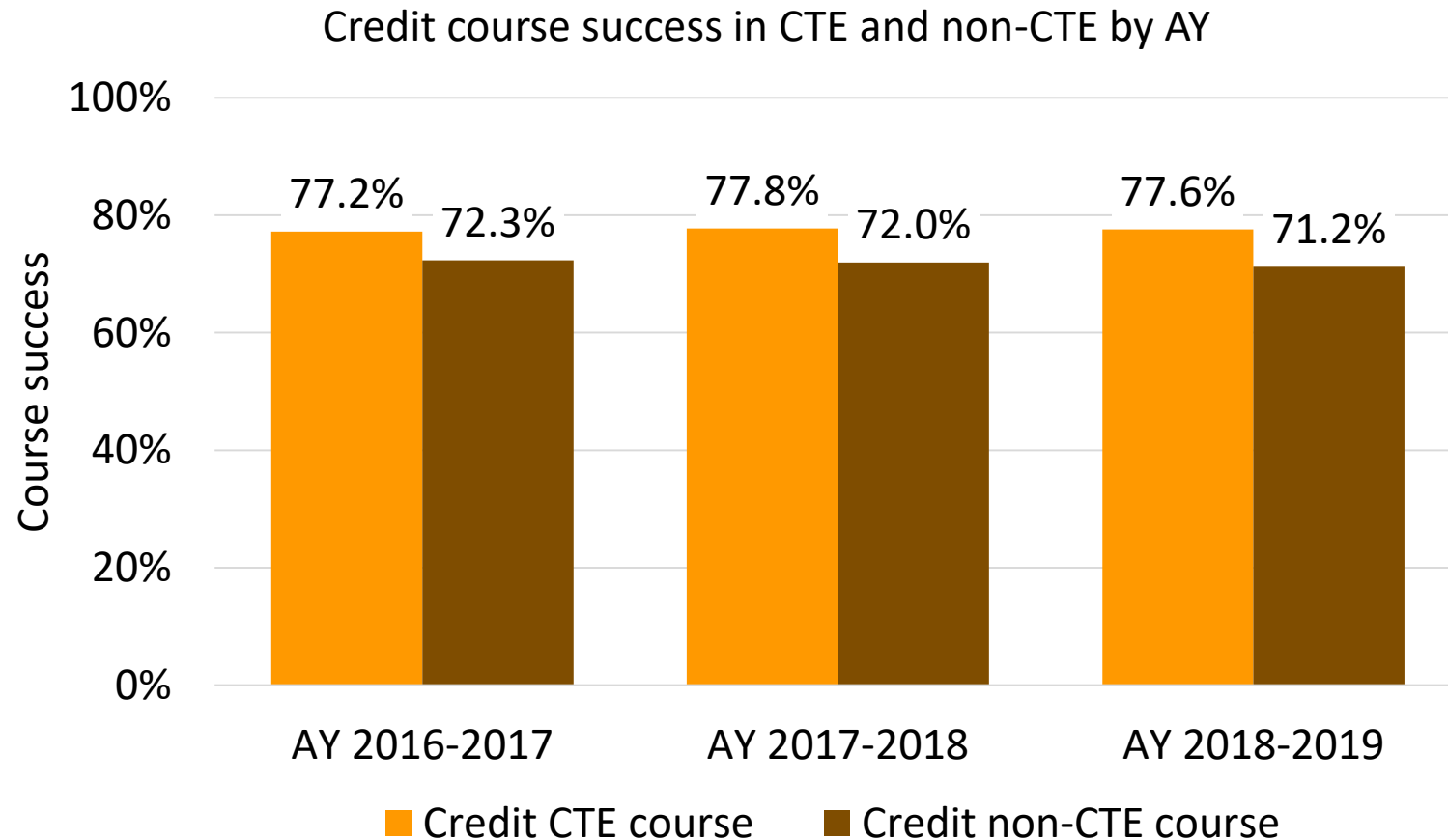
Over the last three AY, CTE FTES increased more than non-CTE FTES.

Over the three selected AY, the number of distinct courses CTE and non-CTE offered has remained nearly constant.

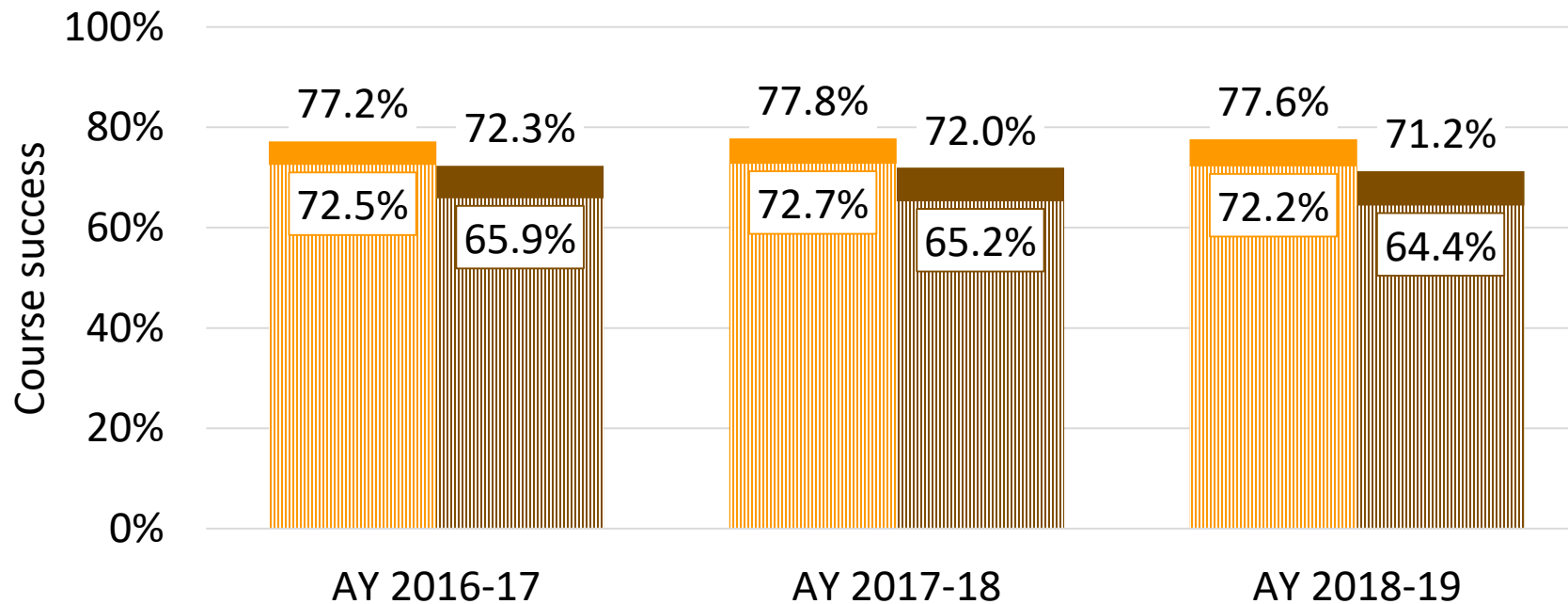
Credit CTE and non-CTE: Course Success

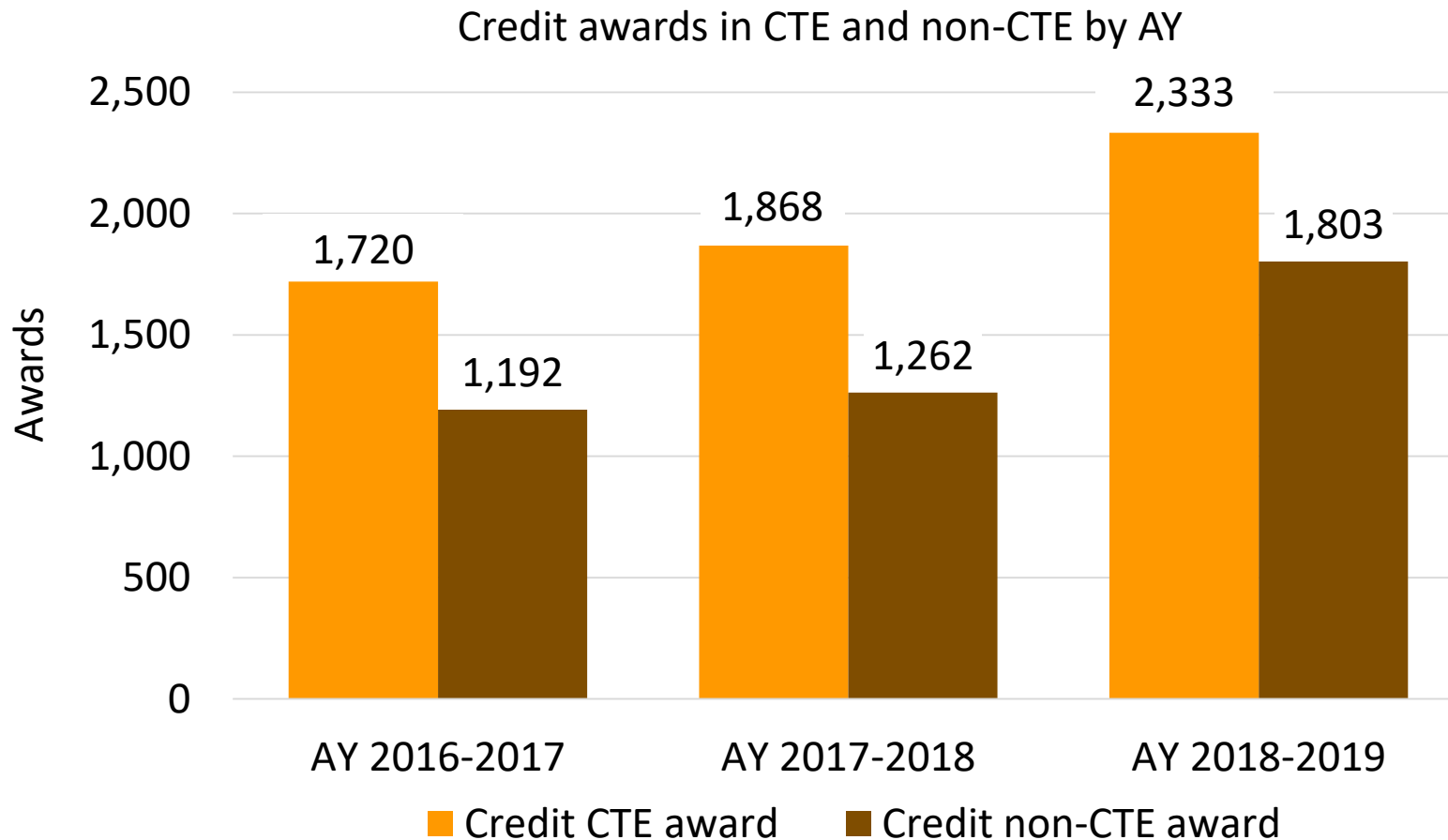

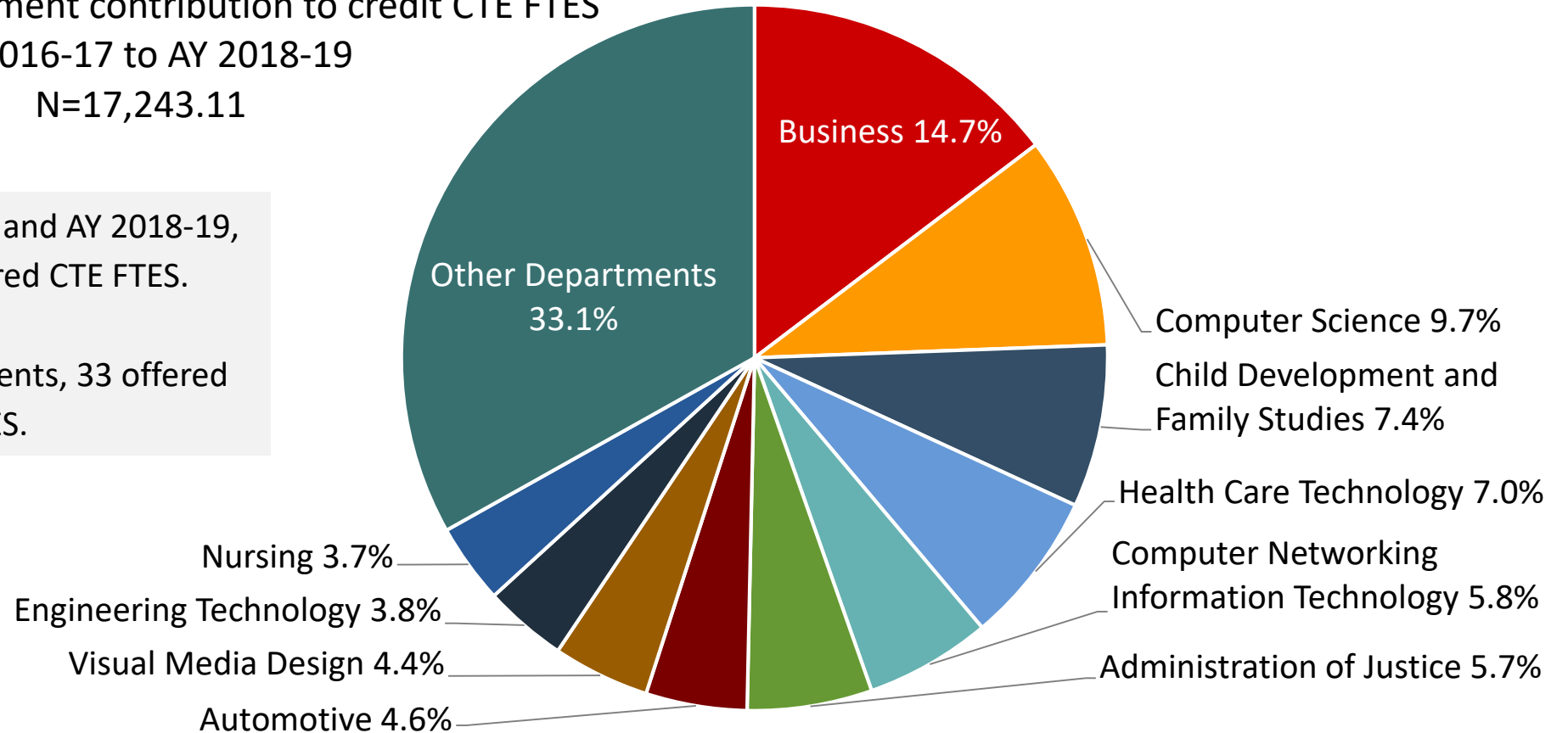
In each of the last three AY, between 56% and 59% of all credit awards were in CTE.

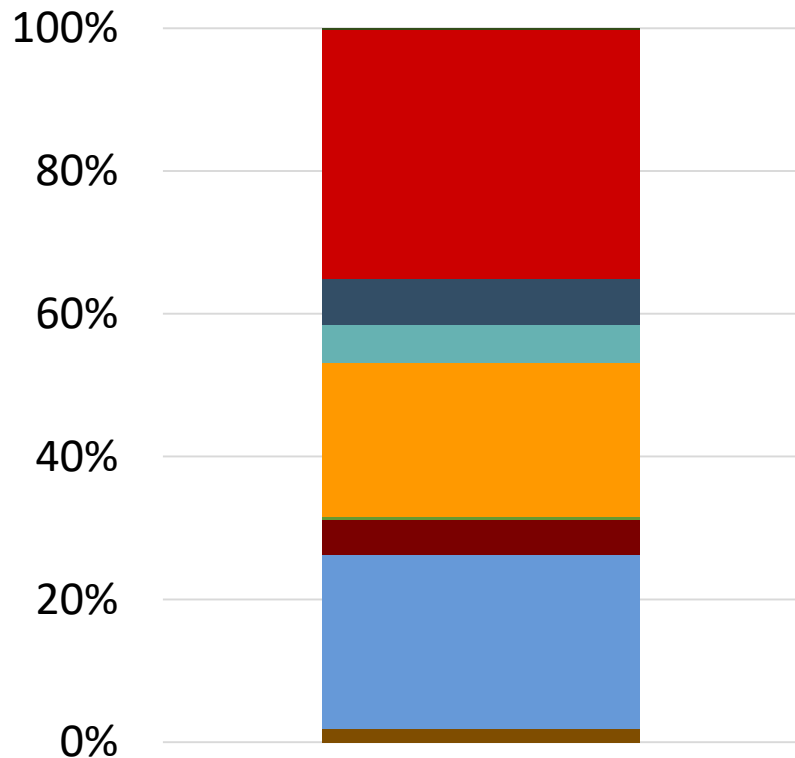

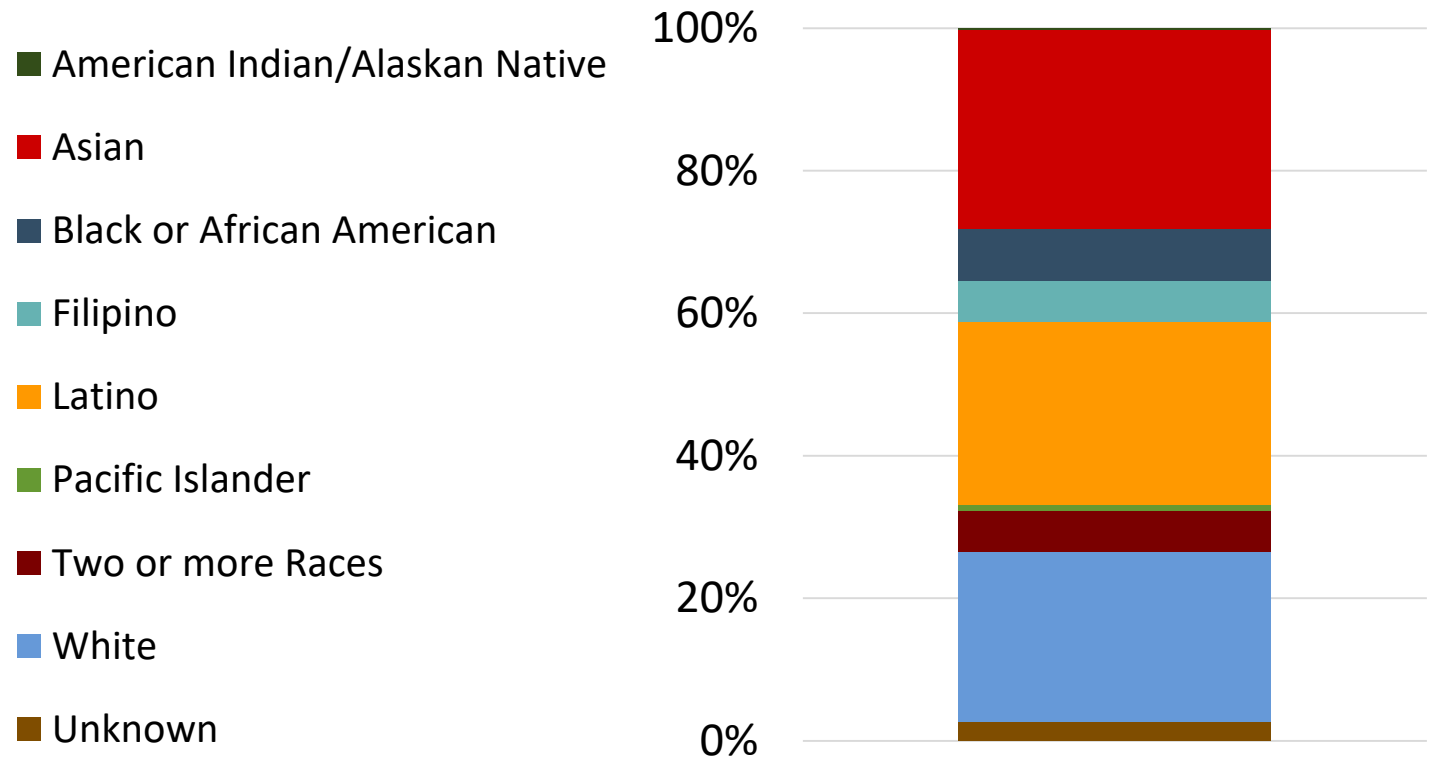


What is the ethnicity distribution of credit CTE and non-CTE students?

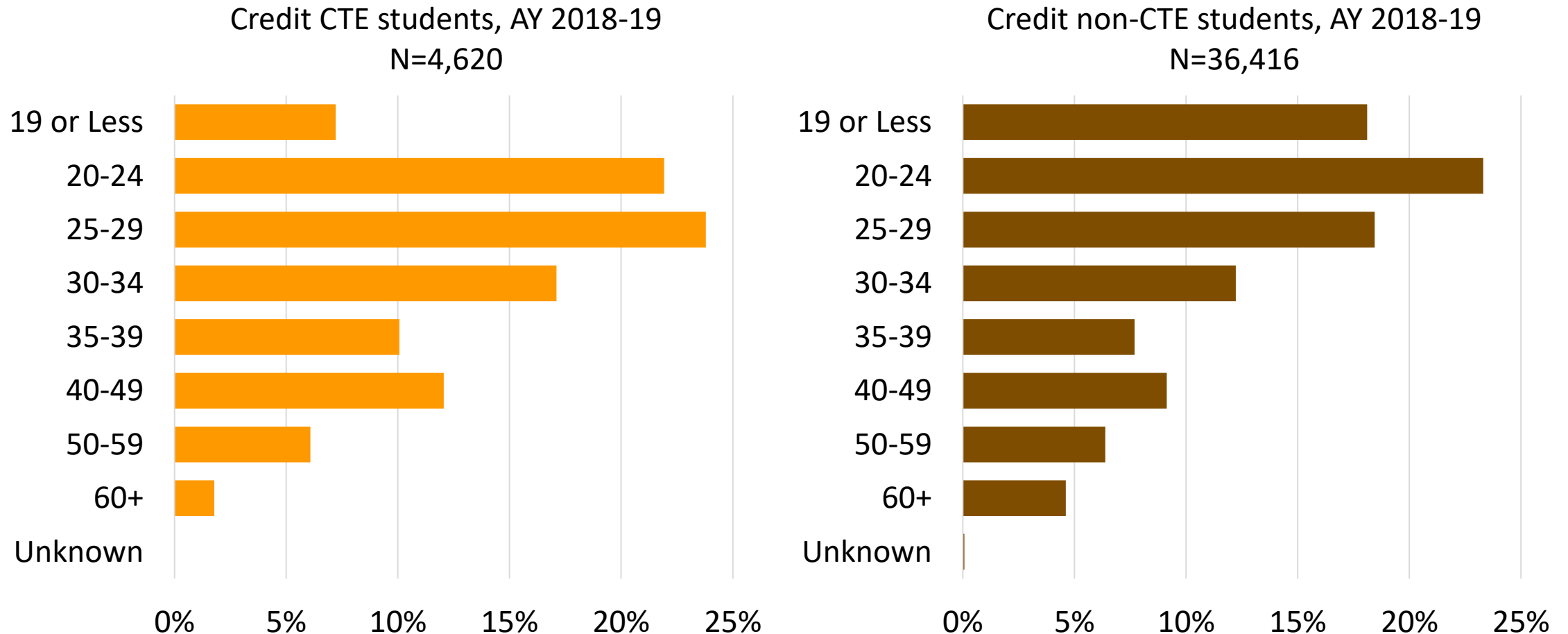

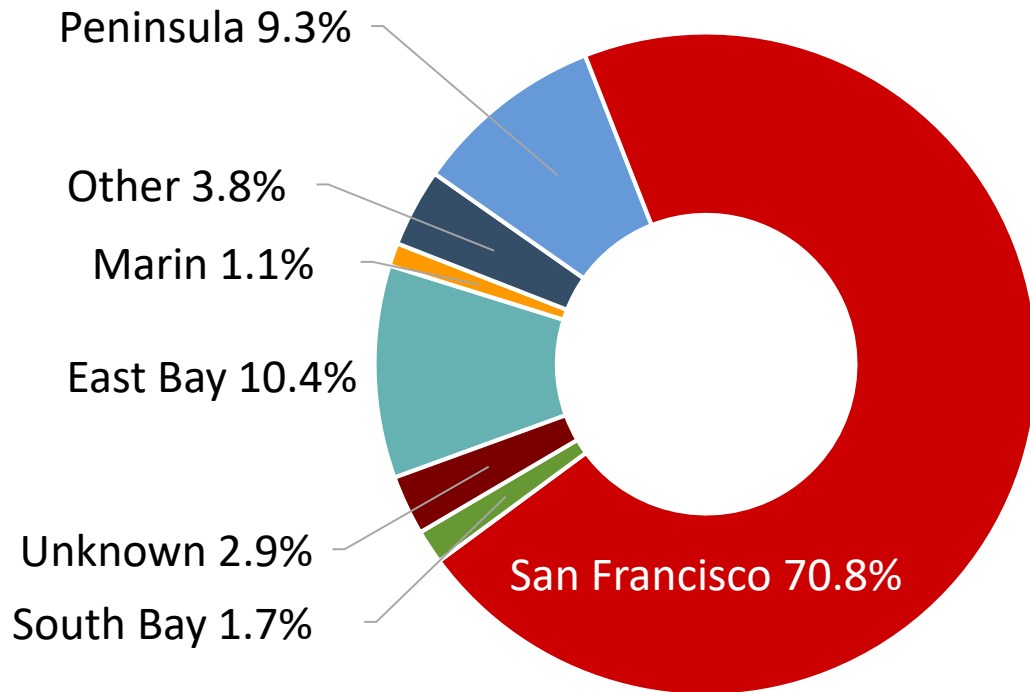


What is the age distribution of credit CTE and non-CTE students?

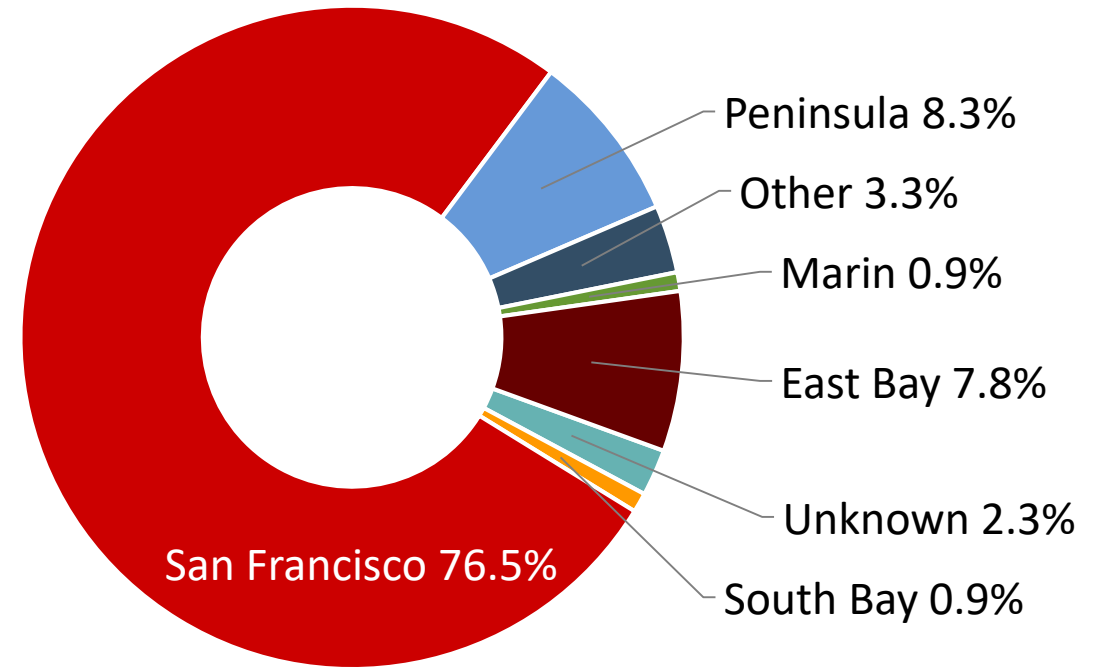


Where do credit CTE and non-CTE students live?

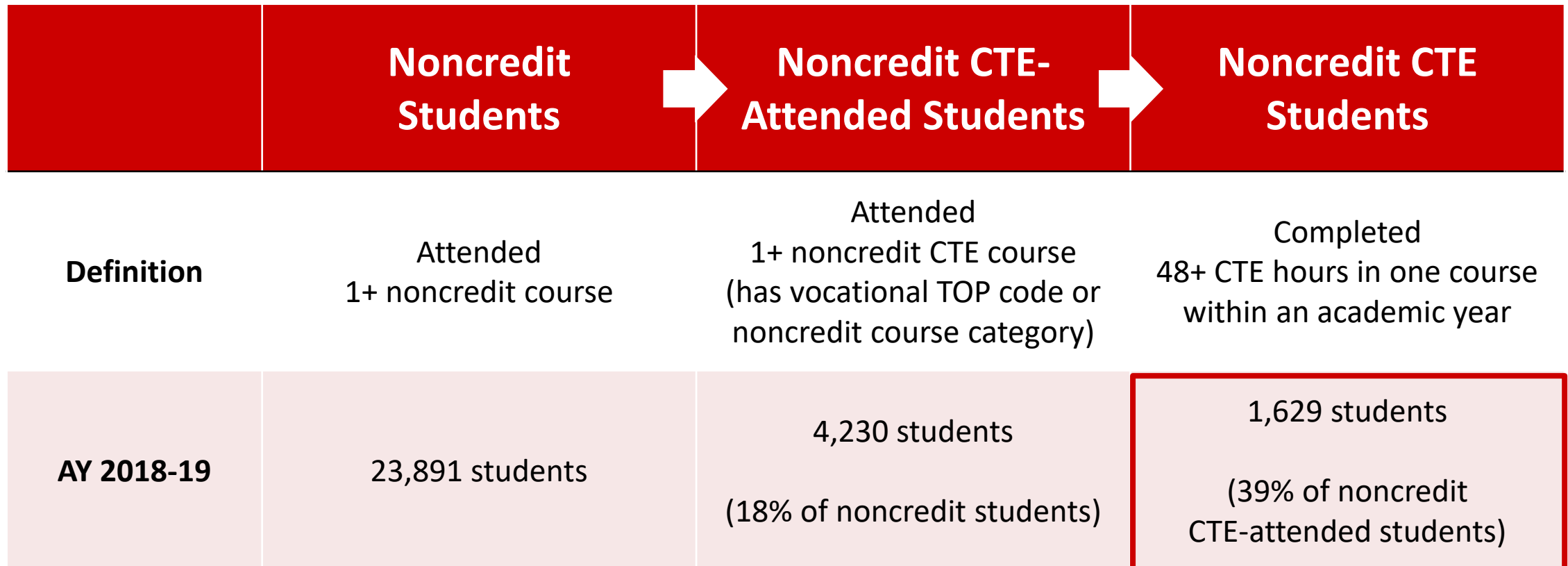


Credit non-CTE students, AY 2018-19

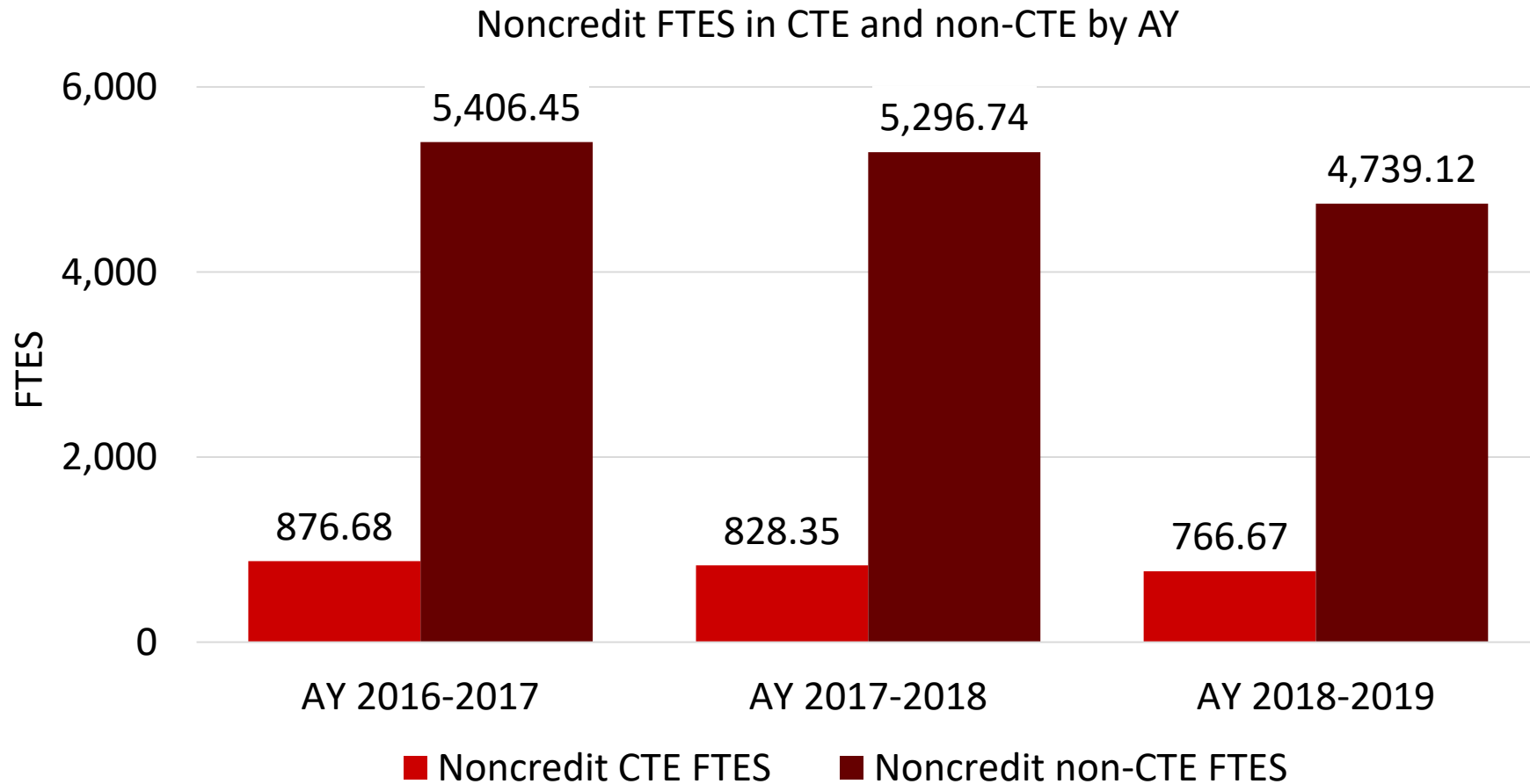

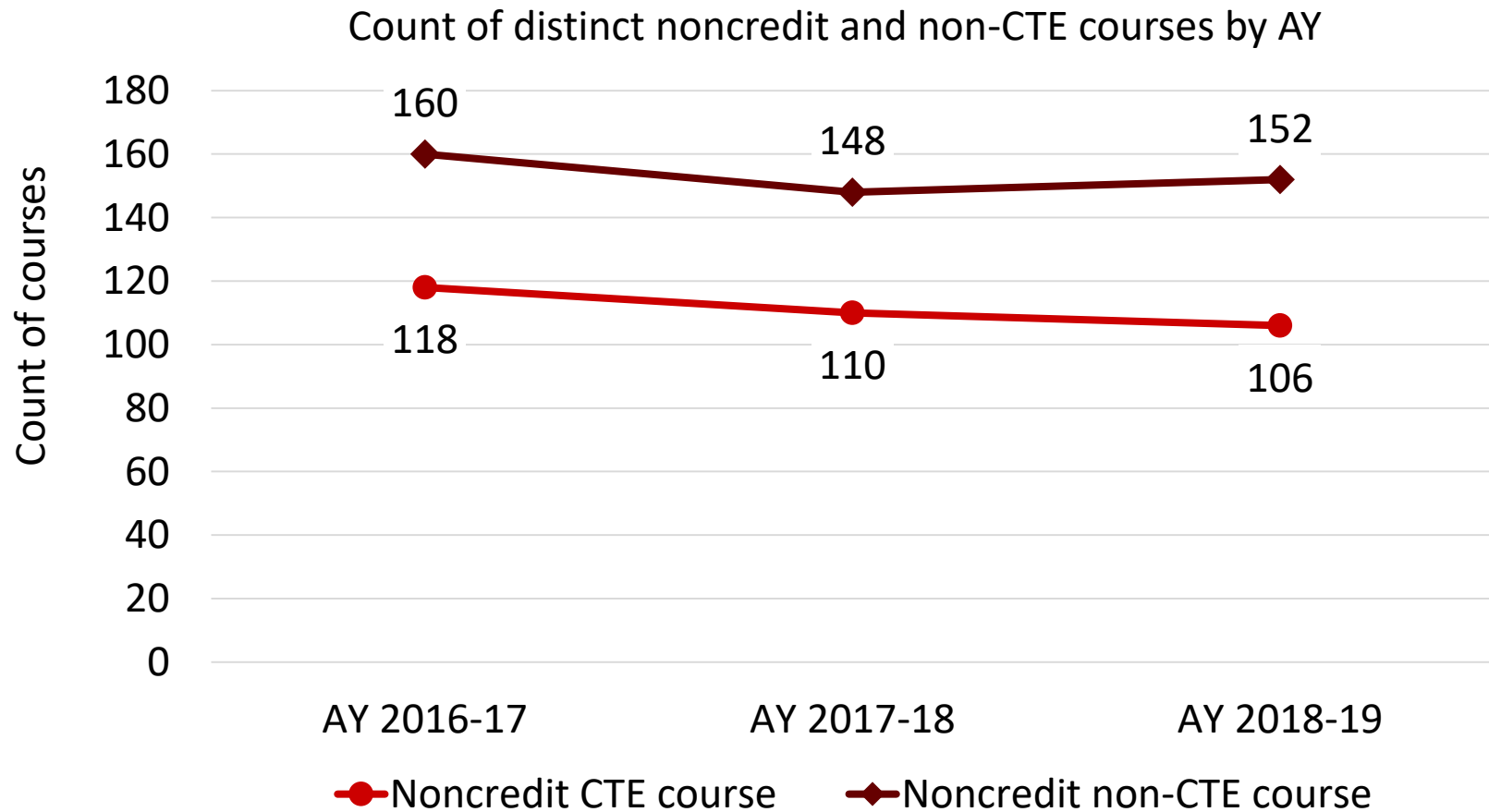


Noncredit CTE and non-CTE: FTES



Over the last three AY, noncredit CTE and non-CTE FTES have decreased.

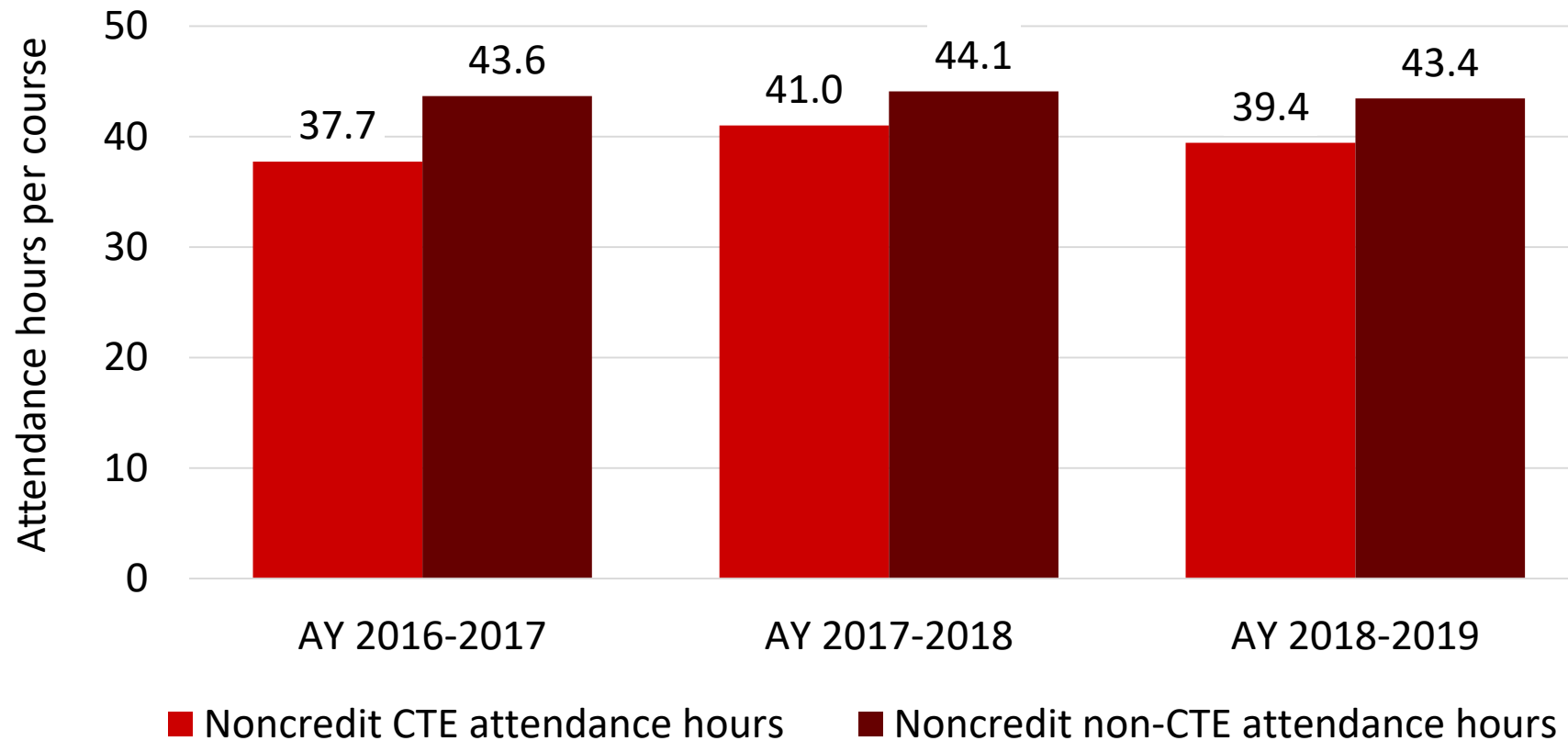
Noncredit CTE and non-CTE: Number of courses offered

Noncredit CTE and non-CTE: Average Hours

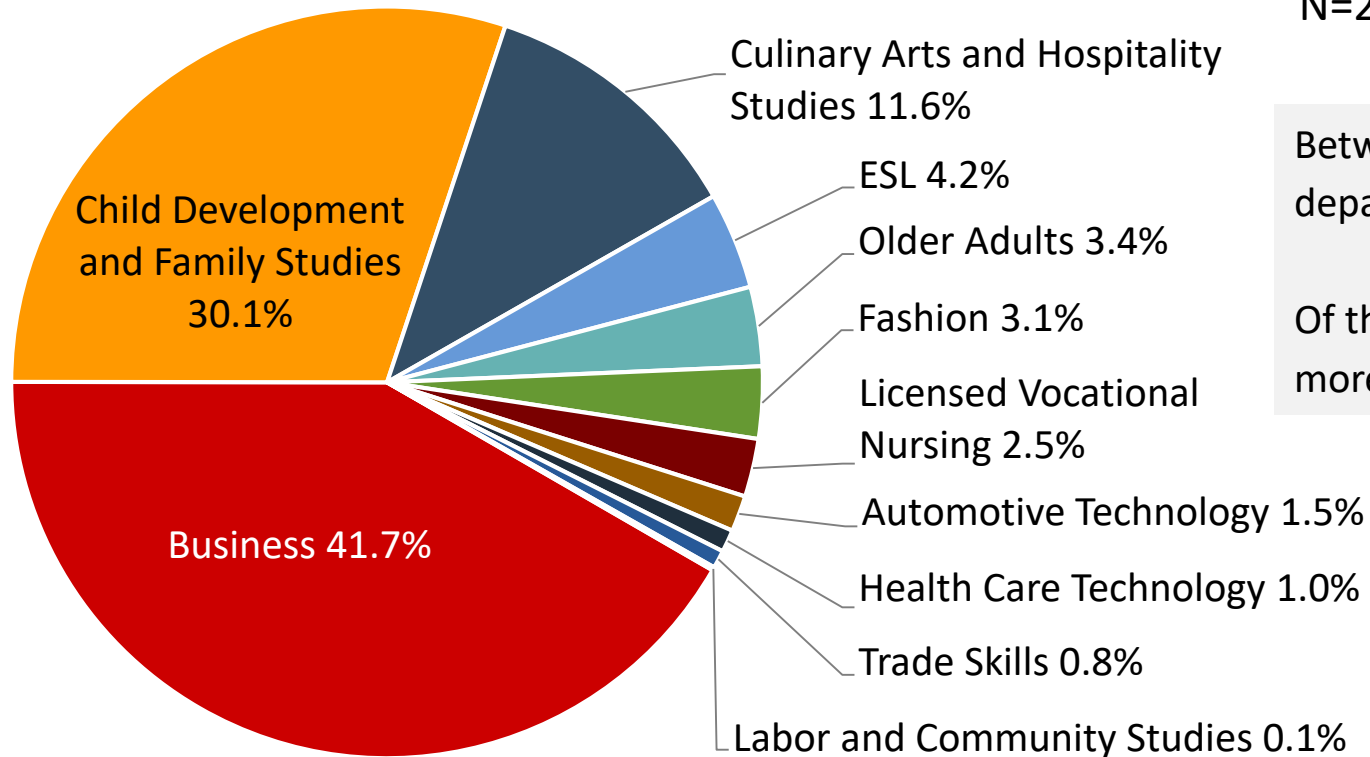
Noncredit CTE and non-CTE average attendance hours per course by AY

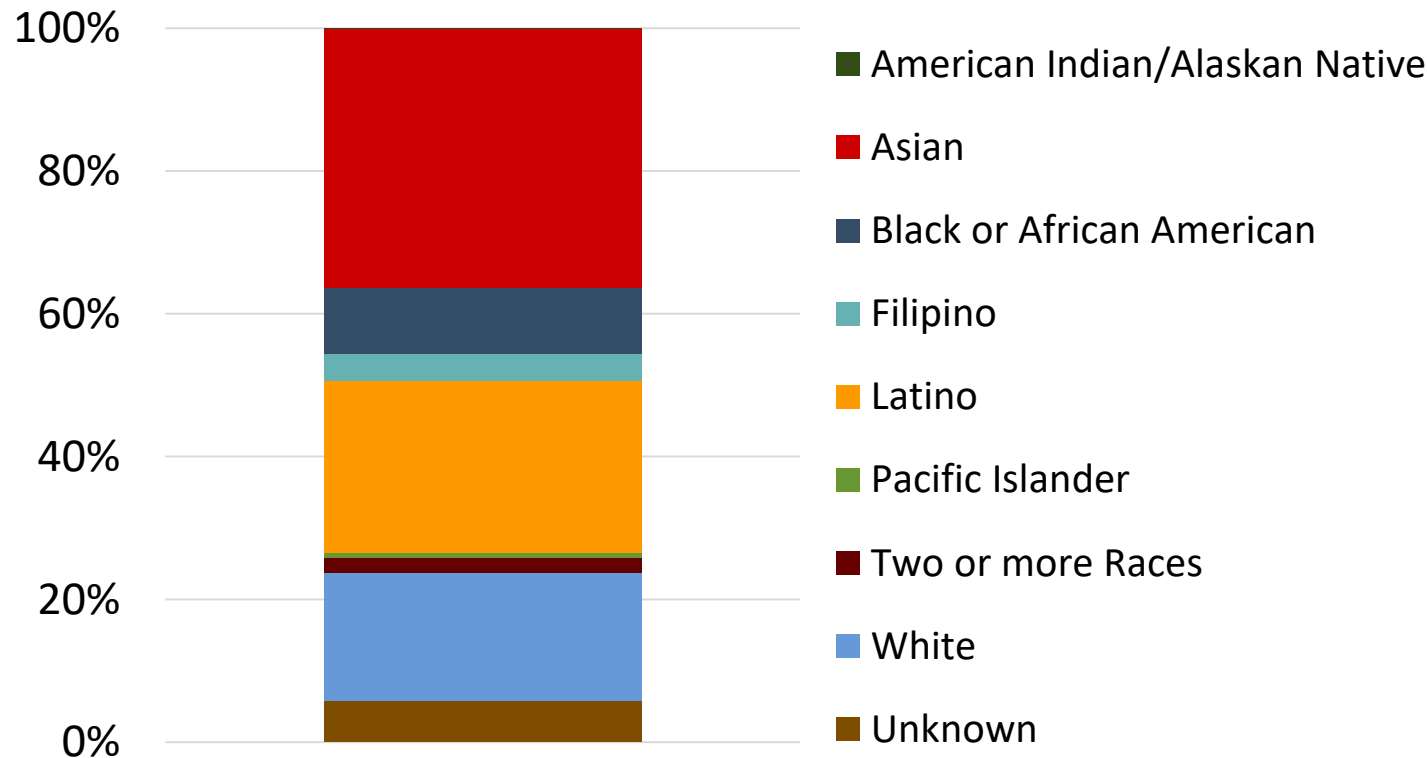


Between AY 2016-17 and AY 2018-19, 11 departments offered CTE FTES.

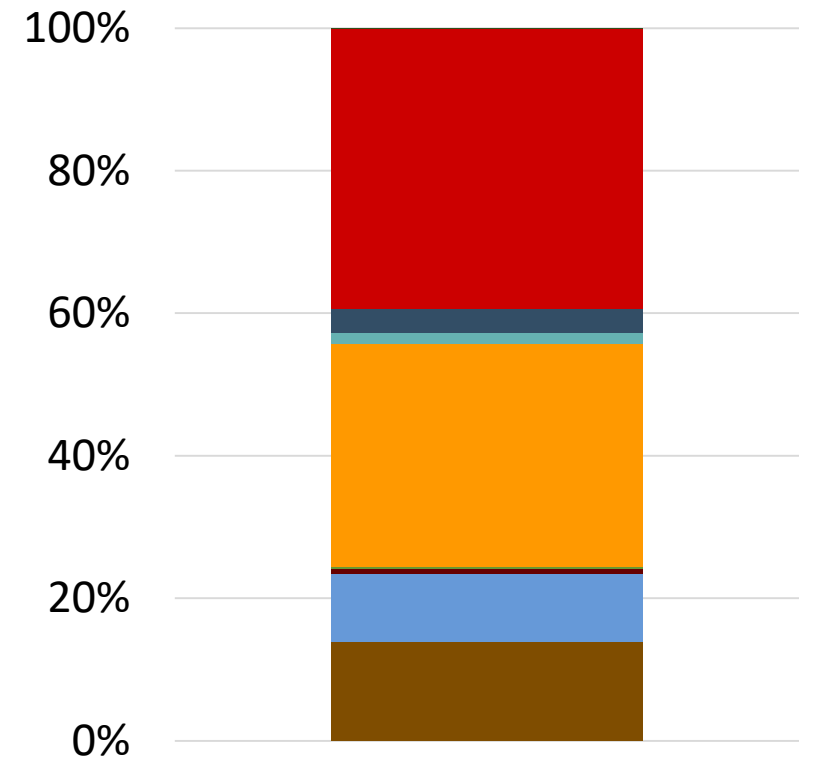

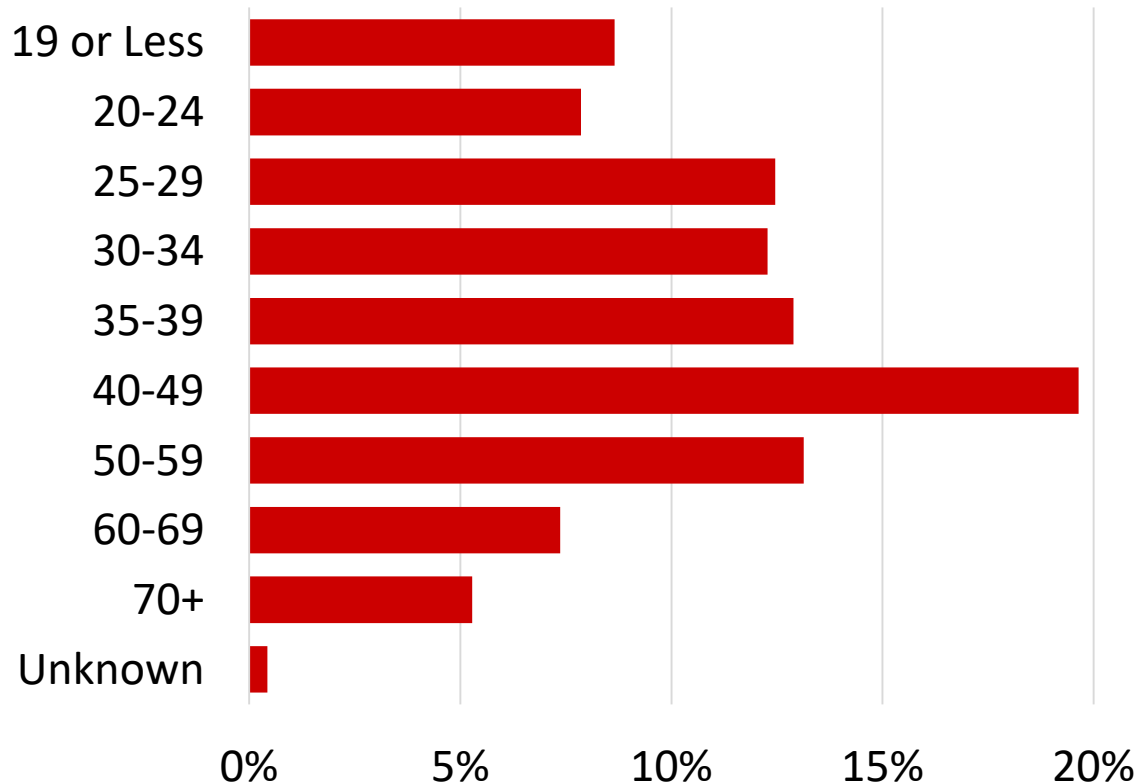


Noncredit non-CTE students, AY 2018-19

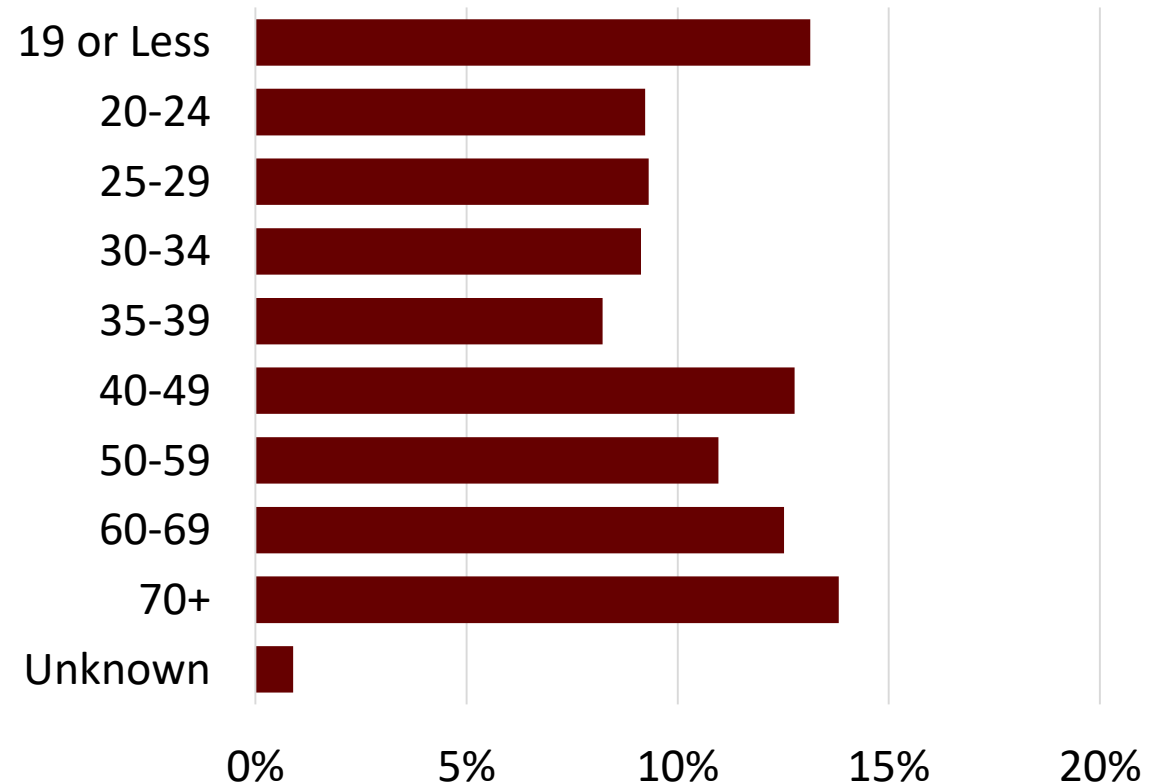


What is the age distribution of noncredit CTE and non-CTE students?

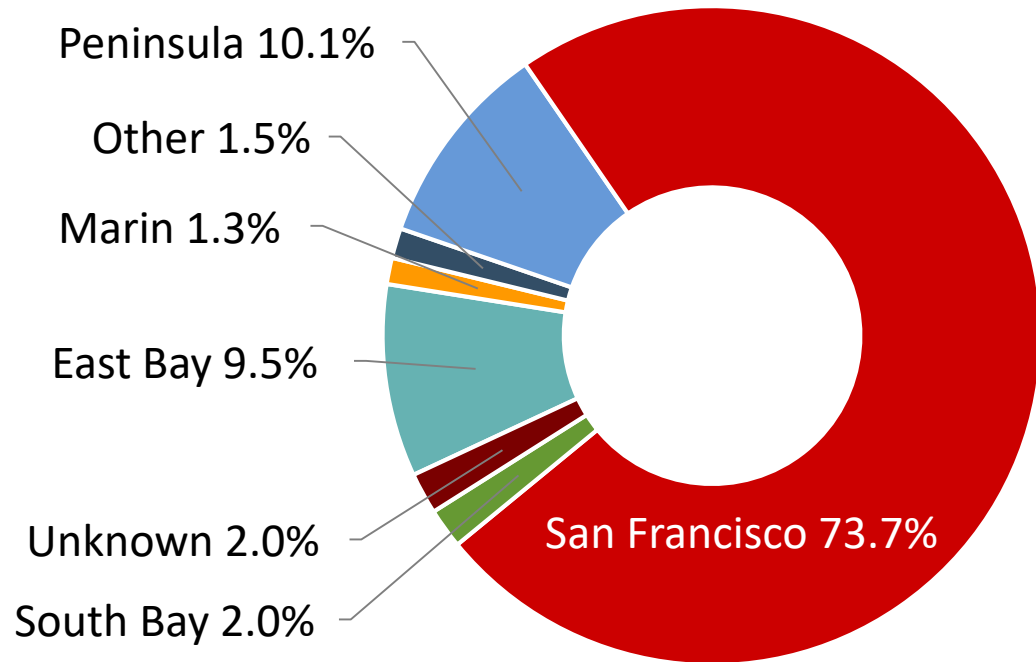


Noncredit non-CTE students, AY 2018-19

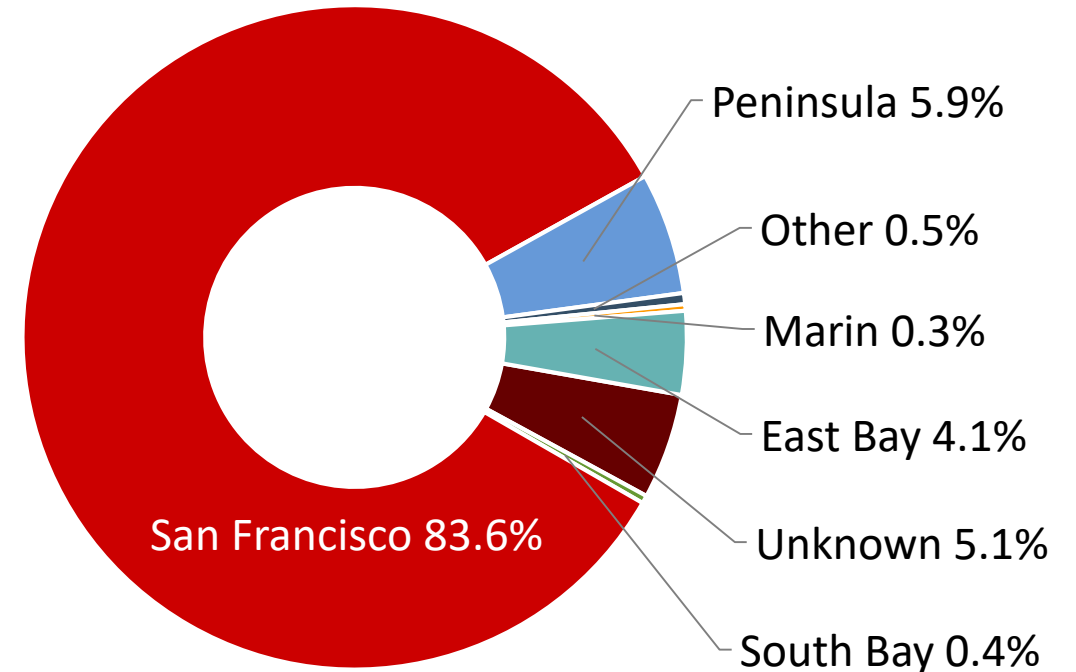


Where do noncredit CTE and non-CTE students live?

Definitions

Terminology:

- Academic Year (AY) – summer, fall, spring
- FTES – full time equivalent students
- Headcount – unduplicated count of students
- CTE – career and technical education
- Noncredit CTE students – students who complete 48 or more hours in a noncredit CTE course within a term during the academic year
- Credit CTE students – students who earn 9 or more CTE units during the academic year

Methodology:

- All data except residency data (ZIP code) retrieved from CCSF Banner PROD, October 8-15, 2019. ZIP code data retrieved from CCSF Banner PROD November 15, 2019.
- CTE and non-CTE student headcount by ZIP code slightly differ from other demographic data due to retrieval at different points in time.
- Demographic data provided for most recent academic year (AY 2018-2019), while trend data provided for the past three AY (AY 2016-2017 through AY 2018-2019), either as a three-year total or year by year as indicated.
- Residence region/ZIP code determined using student's current permanent address at time of data retrieval.
- Annual FTES is a measure that normalizes actual census enrolled units and total attendance hours to 30 units or 525 hours per year.
- CTE courses and programs are identified by a vocational TOP code or, occupational SAM code (CB09) in credit or workforce noncredit category (CB22) codes.
- Age calculated for all students as of August 1st of the academic year.
