CCSF Fact Sheet – Course Success

How many CCSF students are successfully completing their courses?

The successful completion of a course is an important step for students who wish to earn a degree or certificate. In credit, a successful course completion is determined by a grade of C or better.


The percentage of all credit enrollments that resulted in a successful course completion decreased in all semesters from 2020-21 to 2021-22. The overall course success rate during the 2021-22 academic year was 67.9%, ranging between a high of 74.5% in Summer 2021, 69.5% in Spring 2022, and 65.1% in Fall 2021.

Annual credit course success rates by term (2017-18 to 2021-22)
