

CCSF Fact Sheet – Student Residence

Where do CCSF students reside?

A majority of CCSF students reside in San Francisco. Approximately 72% of credit students** are San Francisco residents. CCSF also attracts students from across the Bay Area, with around 8% of students in credit coming from the Peninsula and South Bay, and another 8% from the East Bay.

The overall percentage of CCSF credit students who are San Francisco residents increased until 2020-21. The percentage of credit students in the East Bay, Marin, South Bay, and those living outside of the Bay Area increased between 2019-20 and 2021-22.

** Noncredit headcount data are collected differently during remote instruction, and therefore cannot be reported in the same way as prior years. Residence data are only shown for students enrolled in credit classes.
