



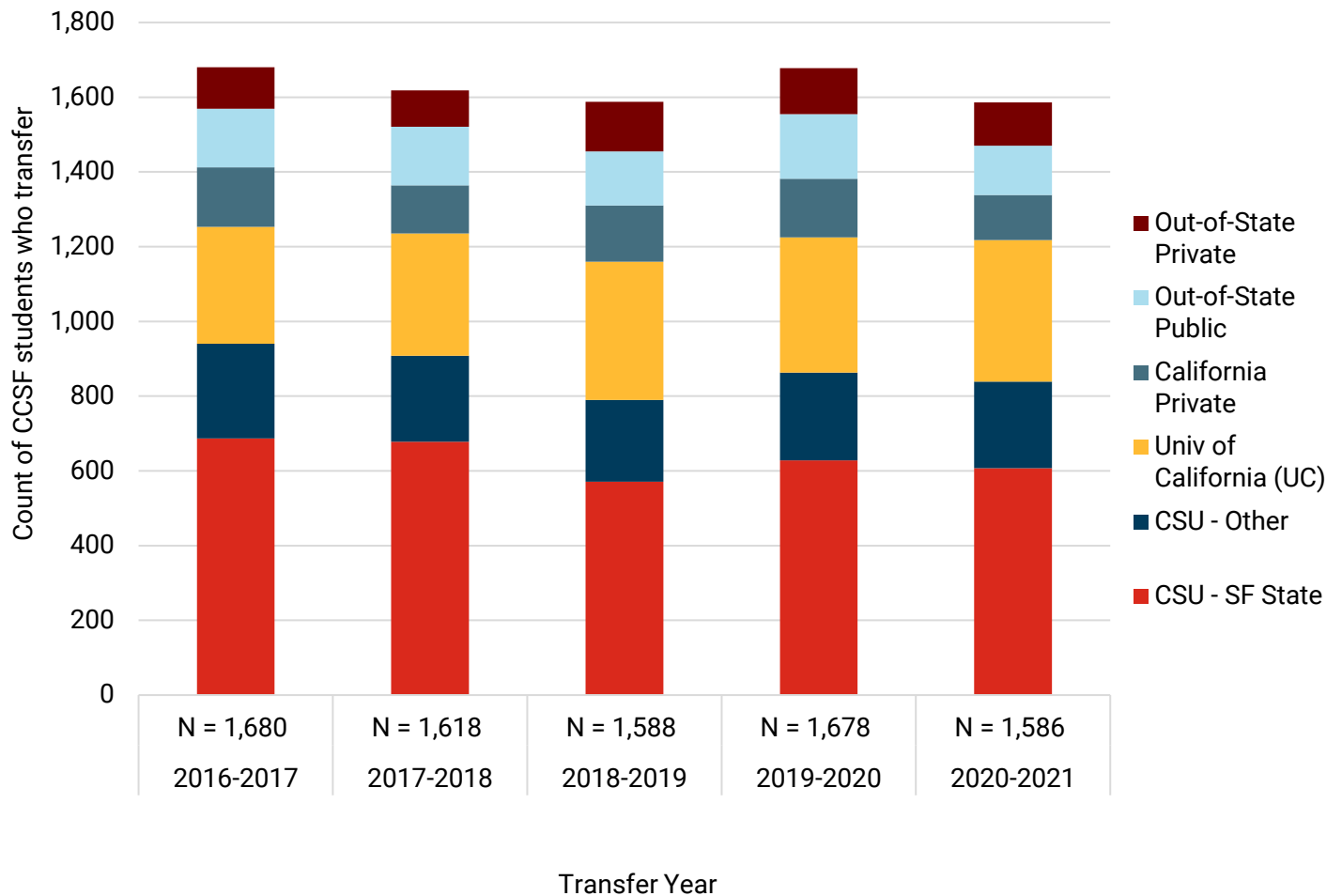
CCSF Fact Sheet – Transfers

CCSF students who transfer to a 4-year college or university

The population of CCSF transfer students includes first time CCSF students who: enrolled at a 4-year college or university within 10 years of their first credit term at CCSF, had no record of enrollment at a 4-year institution prior to their first credit term at CCSF, and earned at least 12 units at CCSF prior to their first enrollment at a 4-year institution. Due to the nature of transfer data collection and reporting, information is shown up to the 2020-21 academic year.

How many CCSF students transfer to a 4-year college or university?

Over the last five years, an average of 1,630 CCSF students have transferred to a 4-year institution each year. Approximately half of CCSF transfer students attended one of the California State Universities (CSUs).

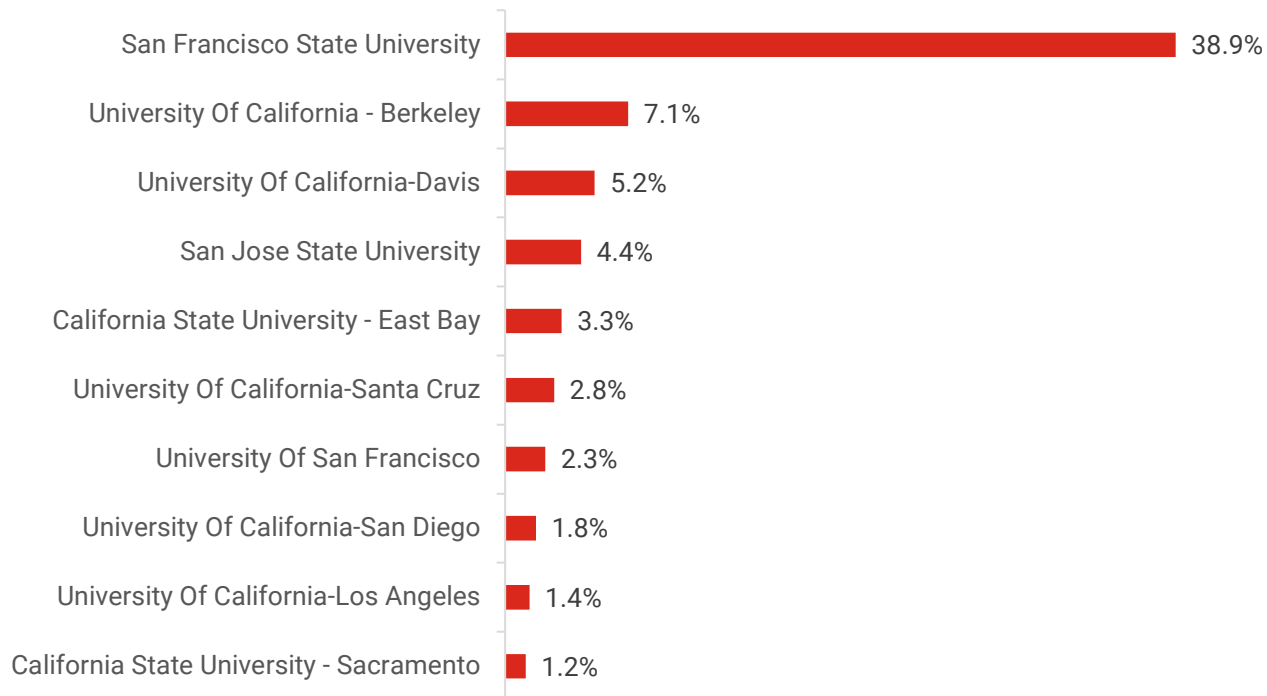

Which colleges and universities are the most common transfer destinations among CCSF students?

Nearly two-thirds (62.7%) of students who transferred during the five-year period from 2016-17 to 2020-21, transferred to one of 10 institutions. Each year, approximately 35-40% of CCSF transfer students transfer to San Francisco State University.
