




How many students take noncredit classes?

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


How many students are in noncredit v. credit?


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
How much of the college's FTES are in noncredit v. credit?



What is the ethnicity distribution of students in noncredit v. credit?




What is the age distribution of students in noncredit v. credit?



Where do students in noncredit classes live?

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
2019-20 Noncredit student headcount by location of residence




How many students attend noncredit classes at each of the Centers?

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
2019-20 Noncredit student term headcount by center



In which departments are students taking noncredit classes?




How many credit students have prior noncredit enrollments?



2019-20 Students enrolled in credit classes and prior noncredit enrollment

- 58% of students enrolled in credit ESL in 2019-20 had enrolled in noncredit ESL in a prior term (792 out of 1,357 students).
- 18% of students enrolled in a credit class, in any subject, in 2019-20, had enrolled in at least one noncredit class in a prior term (6,623 out of 36,573 students).

Definitions

Terminology:

- "Academic Year" Summer, Fall, Spring.
- "Headcount" unduplicated student count, each student is counted once for the year.
- "FTES" full-time equivalent students.

Methodology:

- Data extracted from: CCSF Banner SIS, October 7, 2020.
- Noncredit headcount includes students who have a noncredit enrollment and attend the class for 8 or more hours, in at least one term in the academic year.
 - Does not include enrollments in LERN, ENGL, ESLA 1000 tutorial sections.
- Credit headcount includes students who have an enrollment in a credit class as of the census date for that term, in at least one term during the academic year.
- FTES is calculated by dividing the total actual student attendance hours by 525.
 - Total FTES includes all attendance hours, resident and non-resident, and all attendance hours in LERN, ENGL, ESLA 1000 tutorial sections.
- Age calculated for all students as of August 1st of the academic year.
- Residence region/zip code determined using student's current permanent address.
