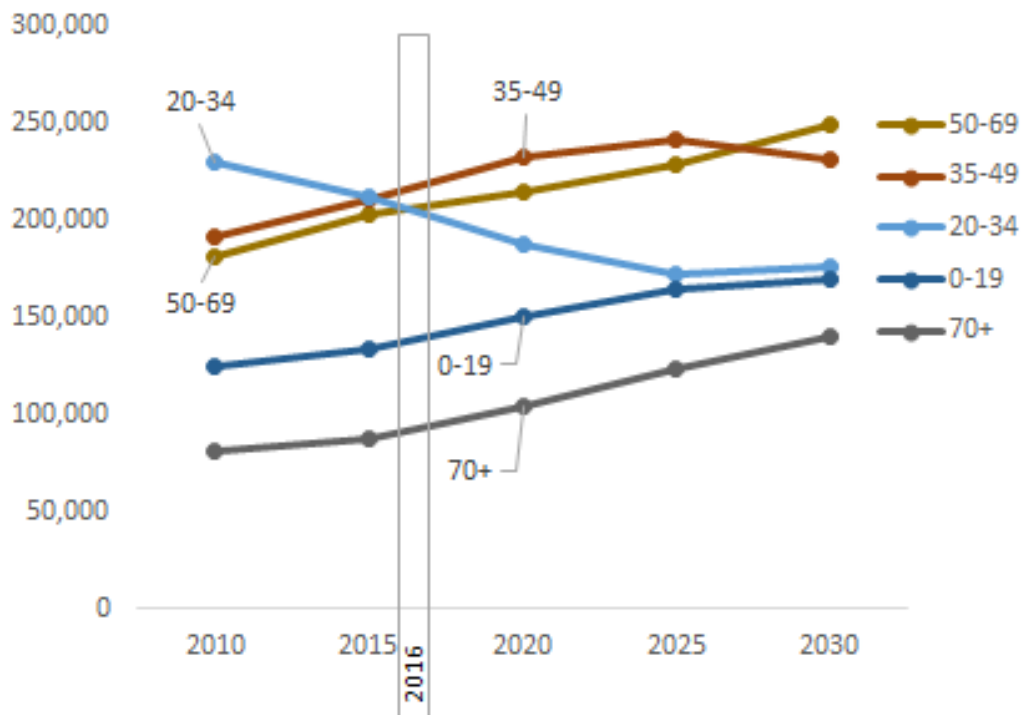


San Francisco Population Projections

California Department of Finance long-term population projections for San Francisco predict substantial increases in the proportion of the population over 50 years old as well as increases in the proportion of young people aged 19 and under. More modest increases are expected among those in the 35–49 year age range. However, the proportion of the population in the 20–34 age range is predicted to decline.
