Pursuant to the provisions of the California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (CUPCCAA, Public Contract Code, Section 22000 et Seq.), the San Francisco Community College District is updating its existing list of Prequalified Contractors who may bid on Informal Projects (projects valued less than \$200,000).

The District shall accept prequalification applications year-round to accommodate contractors in established categories, by dollar amount and trades who wish to be added on the prequalified list. All District approved prequalified vendors within a dollar amount and trade will received a notice to bid on a project.
