## CCSF Fact Sheet – Course Success

## How many CCSF students are successfully completing their courses?

The successful completion of a course is an important step for students who wish to earn a degree or certificate. In credit, a successful course completion is determined by a grade of C or better.


The percentage of all credit enrollments that resulted in a successful course completion decreased in all semesters from 2018-19 to 2021-22, then increased between 2021-22 and 2022-23. The overall course success rate during the 2022-23 academic year was 70.2%, ranging between 78.2% in Summer 2022, 70.8% in Spring 2023, and 68.0% in Fall 2022.

Annual credit course success rates by term (2018-19 to 2022-23)
