

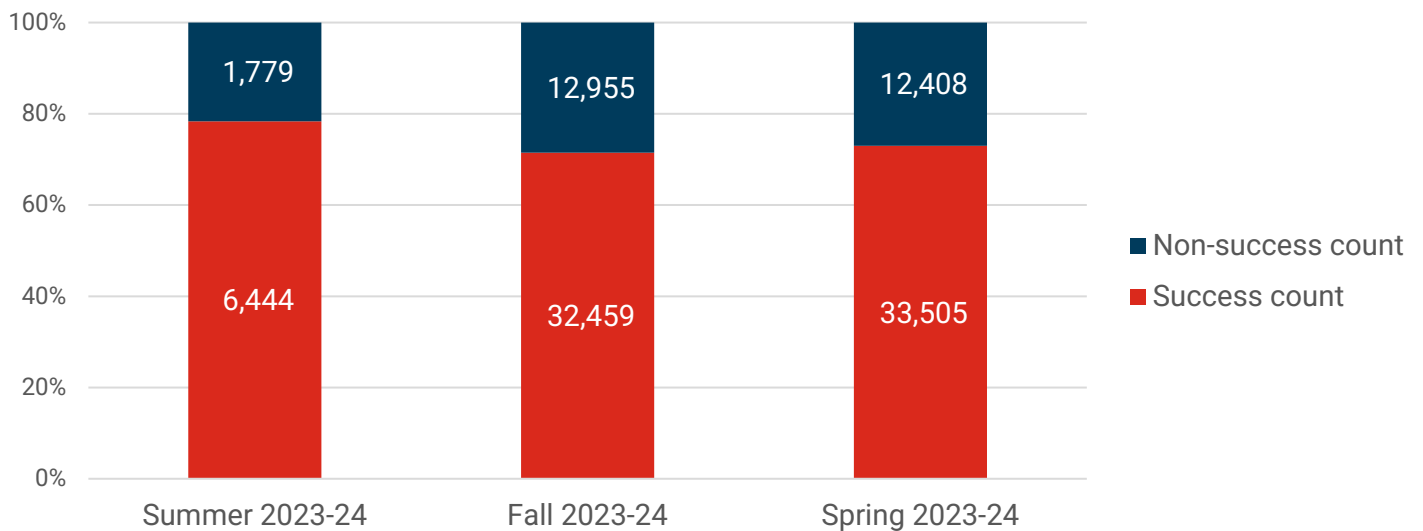


How many CCSF Credit students are successfully completing their courses?

The successful completion of a credit course is an important step for students who wish to earn a degree or certificate. In credit, a successful credit course completion is determined by a grade of C or better.

The percentage of all credit enrollments that resulted in a successful course completion decreased the Summer and Fall semesters from 2019-20 to 2021-22 and experienced a slight increase and following decrease in this time span for the Spring semester. All course success rates have steadily improved from the 21-22 figures to current. The overall course success rate during the 2023-24 academic year was 72.7%, ranging between 78.4% in Summer 2023, 73.0% in Spring 2024, and 71.5% in Fall 2023.
