CAL GETC REQUIREMENTS

To earn an Associate in Arts (AA-T) or an Associate in Science (AS-T) degree from City College of San Francisco, Cal-GETC certification requires completion of the following requirements:

- **Units/GPA:** 11 courses (34 units) in the areas listed on this sheet, all with a grade of “C” or better.
- **GE Areas:** Courses listed in more than one area may only be used for certification in one area.
- **Applicability:** For a course to meet a Cal-GETC requirement, the course must be on the Cal-GETC pattern during the academic year it is taken in the area in which certification is requested.
- **IGETC Courses:** A course taken before Fall 2025 that was on the IGETC pattern the year it was taken, and is approved for the same Cal-GETC Area, may count towards Cal-GETC certification.

There is no equivalent AP exam for Area 1B, 1C, or 6. For International Baccalaureate (IB) exams, a score of 5, 6 or 7 on Higher Level exams is required to grant credit for Cal-GETC certification. CLEP is not accepted for Cal-GETC.

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SPECIAL NOTE FOR TRANSFER STUDENTS: Other coursework outside Cal GETC

The CSU and UC systems have additional graduation requirements. Although these are **not** part of Cal-GETC and are not required for transfer, students are strongly advised to complete these requirements before transferring.

Students who plan to transfer to a CSU are encouraged to complete the U.S. History, Constitution, and American Ideals (AI) Requirement before transfer: six (6) units, one course from Group 1 (US-2&3) and one course from Group 2 (US-1):
