ASSOCIATE DEGREE (AA/AS) GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To earn an Associate in Arts (AA) or an Associate in Science (AS) degree from City College of San Francisco, all students must satisfy these requirements:

- **Units/GPA:** A minimum of 60 degree-applicable units must be completed with an overall grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 (see the College Catalog for a list of degree-applicable courses).
- **Residency:** A minimum of 12 units must be completed at City College of San Francisco.
- **Major Requirement:** Completion of a major, as specified by the department; or completion of 18 semester units in one of the four Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS) Areas of Emphasis. Grade of “C” or “P” or better for each major course is required.
- **General Education (GE):** All students must complete one of the general education patterns:
 1. The local CCSF general education pattern, detailed below, must be completed with an overall 2.0 GPA, including completion of Areas 1A and 2 with a grade of “C” or higher
 2. The Cal-GETC singular transfer GE pattern (see the Cal-GETC advising sheet)
- **Local Graduation Requirements:** Students must complete the U.S. History & Government (3 units) and Health & Wellness (1-3 units) graduation requirements.
- **Exemptions:** Students who hold a baccalaureate degree from an institutionally-accredited institution do not need to complete GE Areas 1-6 or the U.S. History and Government & Health and Wellness requirements.
- **File Petition for Associate Degree:** Meet with an academic counselor to complete a “Petition for Associate Degree (AA/AS)” form. Submit petition form to the Office of Admission and Records, SSC, Room 1124 by the deadline. **Deadline to submit:** _____
