Get Ready for Online Learning


Welcome to your online ESL class at CCSF! This guide helps you:

- 1. Set up your myCCSF Portal / RAM ID
- 2. Log in to Canvas for your online class
- 3. Attend live class meetings on **Zoom**

Set Up myCCSF Portal (RAM ID)

Note: **Wait 24 hours** after you receive your student ID number before setting up your myCCSF Portal (RAM ID).


1. Go to www.ccsf.edu and click MyCCSF in the top menu.



2. Click myCCSF Login Portal (RAM ID) to open the student portal page.



3. Click New to RAM ID? Forgot Password?



4. For **Username**, enter your **Student ID**. It starts with S, W, WA, or @.



5.



Answer the 3 questions, then click **Next** to continue.


Note:

- Enter your date of birth in MMDDYY format.
 Example: April 4, 1998 → 040498.
- Your answers must match CCSF records exactly!
- If you cannot answer the questions correctly, please email nc_admit@ccsf.edu for help.

6. **Create a password** following the rules in the green box. Enter your password twice, then click **Continue**.


If accepted, you will see **Password Reset Successfully**. Select **Click here to continue**.



7. Select 2 questions and type your answers. Then, click **Continue**. **Note**: These questions will help you recover your password in the future. Choose answers you will remember.



8. **Optional**: Enter your 10-digit **mobile phone number** and/or **email address** to receive a security code. Enter the code to **continue**, or click **Skip** to move past this step.



You have now set up your RAM ID!

Use it to log in to Canvas and join your online classes.


Attend Online Classes with Canvas

Canvas is an online learning system. You'll use it to access class materials, join Zoom, message your teacher, and submit assignments.

You can use Canvas in a web browser (like Chrome) or on a mobile app.


Access Canvas in a Web Browser

- 1. Go to www.ccsf.edu
- 2. Click CANVAS in the top menu
- 3. Log in with your myCCSF RAM ID and password



Access Canvas on a Smartphone

- 1. Go to the **App Store** (iPhone) or **Google Play** (Android)
- 2. Search for Canvas Student
- 3. Download and open the app
- 4. Select Find my School → type City College of San Francisco
- 5. Log in with your myCCSF RAM ID and password




Explore Canvas Dashboard


When you log in to Canvas:

- You will see your available classes on the **Dashboard**.
- Important: Classes appear about 24 hours registration or the first day of the semester.

Four important buttons in Canvas

- 1. Home: Information about your class and teacher
- 2. **CityZoom**: Zoom link to online class meetings
- 3. **Modules**: Class lessons and assignments
- 4. **Inbox**: Send messages to your teacher

Attend Online Classes with Zoom


Most online classes meet on **Zoom**. You'll join your teacher and classmates to learn and practice English together.

Join Your Zoom Class

- 1. Open your class in Canvas.
- 2. Click CityZoom.
- 3. Find your class date and time. Click Join.

Note: The first time you use Zoom, you may need to download and install the Zoom app.








Important Buttons in Zoom

Attend Online Classes

Canvas Dashboard

- Log in to Canvas.
- Click on the **course tile** to enter your class.
- Check your schedule for **live Zoom meetings** in **CityZoom**.
- Go to **Modules** to review lessons, discussions, and assignments.

Meet Your Teacher

On the first day, your teacher will explain what the class is about and how you will learn.

If you join late, send a short Canvas Inbox message to introduce yourself.

Hello [Teacher's Name],

My name is [your name]. I'm happy to join your class!

This shows your teacher that you can use Canvas and are ready for online learning.

You can ask questions anytime—your teacher is here to help!

Classroom Activities

Everyone is welcome at CCSF!

You will learn by speaking, listening, reading, or writing through short lessons, group work, and discussions.

These activities help you improve your English and make friends, too!

You can practice English without fear. Mistakes are okay; they help you learn.
