Suspicious, Odd, and Harassing Behavior

**Incident Reported:** Monday, November 3rd, 2025

**Time Occurred:** 5pm

Location: Q-Lot, South Side of the Harry Britt Building (HBB)

**Victim:** CCSF Student and CCSF Employee

Subject: Latino Male Adult, long curly hair, mid 20's, 5'08, 200 pounds,

wearing a white hoodie, blue jeans, and black backpack.

On 11/03/2025 at 5pm, a CCSF employee was approached by the subject in the Q-Lot, located closest to the Bus Terminal. The subject was acting odd, smiling, was non-verbal, while walking towards the employee. The employee backed away, screamed, and threatened to call the police which caused the subject to redirect and run southbound toward Ocean Ave.

## **Related Incidents:**

On 09/16/2025 at approx. 4:45pm, the same subject followed a student from the HBB Q-lot's west side around the building to the HBB Q-lot's east side (Frida Kahlo side). The subject ran up to the student with his hand stretched outwards as if to grab her. The student stepped to the side, screamed, and another person in the area came to her aid. Subject never said a word before or after the incident and walked southbound toward the Bus Terminal.

On 10/09/2025 at 4:30pm, a student entered the HBB and noticed the subject sitting down. As the student walked past the subject, he began to laugh, stood up and lunged at the student, but did not touch the student. The subject then entered the men's 1<sup>st</sup> floor restroom.

- 4) Trust your instincts, don't hesitate to take action
- 5) Run or walk away from the trouble and seek help
- 6) If possible, use your phone to take pictures or record
- 7) Call 415-239-3200 or use an emergency blue phone immediately
- 8) Provide suspect description/s, direction of flight, and advise if weapons were used
- 9) Carry pepper spray, whistle, or your keys in hand to be used as a defensive weapon
