Whereas the current RAMID portal application does not offer a conditional Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA), which will meet our cybersecurity requirements but will also lessen the credential verification burden for our user community, and

Whereas our students' expectations of having a modern and hyper-personalized platform are not met, and

Whereas many California Community Colleges ([Montgomery County Community College](#), [Santa Barbara City College](#), [Antelope Valley College](#), College of the Sequoias, etc.) that are searching for a newer Student Portal have mostly selected [Pathify](#), and

Whereas the Student Access and Matriculation Advisory Committee (SAMAC) was able to see a demo of [Pathify](#) be it

Resolved that the Student Access and Matriculation Advisory Committee (SAMAC) acknowledges the need for a more suitable Student Portal, tailored to our current needs and be it further
