**Sexual Battery**

**Incident Reported:** 12/02/2025

**Time Reported:** 11:30am

**Incident Occurred:** **October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2025**

**Time Occurred:** Approximately 9:30am

**Location:** Arts Plaza area between Visual and Creative Arts Building

**Victim:** Student

**Suspect:** Possibly Hispanic male with tan skin, 20 to 25 years old, heavy set, approx. 180 pounds, 5'6" tall, and dark shoulder length hair

The victim was walking southbound through the Arts Plaza located between the Creative and Visual Arts buildings. During this time, the victim heard a voice, and the suspect approached the victim from behind, reached around, and grabbed the victim's breasts over the victim's clothing. The victim immediately ran away from the suspect.

**Prevention Tips:**

- 1) Always protect yourself
- 2) Walk in groups
- 3) Be aware of your surroundings
- 4) Draw attention to yourself by yelling when assistance is needed
- 5) Trust your instincts, don't hesitate to take action
- 6) Run or walk away from the trouble and seek help
- 7) If possible, use your phone to take pictures or record
- 8) Immediately call 415-239-3200 or use an emergency blue phone
- 9) Provide suspect description/s, direction of flight, and advise if weapons were used
- 10) Carry pepper spray, a whistle, or your keys in hand to be used as a defensive weapon
