Warm-Up BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Gear 01

A PERSONAL EMAIL

Use one you check often — not a high school address, since you may lose access to it after graduation.

Gear 02

YOUR SCHOOL HISTORY

Have the names and attendance dates for every high school and college you've attended.

Gear 03

PERSONAL DETAILS

Legal name, birthdate, mailing address, and phone number. A Social Security number is optional.

Select "Get Started Now" to start the enrollment guide for your student type.
- 02**

SIGN IN OR CREATE AN OPENCCC ACCOUNT

One OpenCCC account works at any California community college. This login is separate from myRAM, the portal you'll use once you're enrolled.

- 03**

CHOOSE CITY COLLEGE OF SAN FRANCISCO

Confirm CCSF as your college and select your intended program of study and education goal.
- 04**

PICK YOUR TERM AND VERIFY YOUR IDENTITY

Select the term you're starting. ID.me identity verification is optional but speeds up processing and helps protect your financial aid from fraud.
- 05**

REVIEW AND SUBMIT

Double-check your answers before submitting. You'll get a confirmation on screen right away.

AFTER YOU SUBMIT

1st

WATCH YOUR INBOX

A welcome email arrives within 24 hours with your CCSF Student ID and RAM ID. Contact Admissions if it doesn't show up.

2nd

LOG INTO MYRAM

Use your new credentials — separate from OpenCCC — to view holds, financial aid, and your class schedule.

3rd

FINISH ORIENTATION, AID, AND REGISTRATION

Complete New Student Orientation, file your FAFSA or CA Dream Act form (CCSF school code 012874), then register for classes.
