Sexual Battery

Incident Occurred: **March 18th, 2026**
Time Occurred: Approximately 3:00pm
Location: HBB Parking Lot's North Driveway
Victim: Non-Student

Suspect: Hispanic male adult, 5' 7", approximately 28 years old, greasy hair, wiry black beard, grayish teeth, black pants, dirty white t-shirt, black backpack, black athletic shoes, with a medium build.

The victim was walking southbound on Frida Kahlo Way on the west side of the street's sidewalk. As the victim approached the HBB parking lot's north driveway exit, the suspect approached the victim from behind and grabbed the victim's buttocks. The victim turned away from the suspect and said, "Don't touch me bitch" causing the suspect to walk away. Afterwards, the victim used their cellular phone to record the suspect walking on the east side of the street toward Ocean Ave.

Utilizing the victim's cell phone footage, we were able to use our surveillance cameras to track the suspect at the Muni Bus Loop leaving on a bus. **Suspect pictures below:**

Prevention Tips:

- 1) Always protect yourself
- 2) Walk in groups
- 3) Be aware of your surroundings
- 4) Draw attention to yourself by yelling when assistance is needed
- 5) Trust your instincts, don't hesitate to take action
- 6) Run or walk away from the trouble and seek help
- 7) If possible, use your phone to take pictures or record
- 8) Immediately call 415-239-3200 or use an emergency blue phone
- 9) Provide suspect description/s, direction of flight, and advise if weapons were used
- 10) Carry pepper spray, a whistle, or your keys in hand to be used as a defensive weapon
